



3B9 - Olof, G0CKV will be active again as 3B9HA from Rodrigues Island (AF-017) from 24 November to 12 December. He will operate CW, with main activity during the CQ WW DX CW Contest and a focus on the low bands outside the contest. QSL via M0OXO's OQRS

5N - Tom, PA3TG will be active again as 5N/PA3TG from Nigeria on 15-25 November. He will be QRV on 30 metres CW and 20 metres SSB & CW mainly during his evening hours. QSL via home call, direct or bureau. [TNX DX World]
