

# DX INFORMATION

**3A** - Bodo, DF8DX will be active as 3A/DF8DX from Monaco on 29 and/or 30 April, between 17 and 20 UTC. He will operate CW only on 17 and/or 20 metres. QSL via Club Log's OQRS. [TNX The Daily DX]

**3W** - Peter, DF7DQ will be active holiday style as 3W9DQ from Phan Thiet, Vietnam on 1-10 May. He will operate CW, SSB and RTTY on 40, 30, 20, 17 and 15 metres. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, LoTW, or via home call. [TNX The Daily DX]

**3W** - Yuri, RM0F will be active holiday style as 3W9FU from Nha Trang, Vietnam on 1-10 May. He will operate CW, SSB and digital modes on 40-10 metres. He might be QRV as 3W9FU/p from IOTA group AS-157 for 2-3 days during that time frame. QSL via Club Log's OQRS and LoTW, or via home call (direct or bureau).

**40** - Giuseppe, IK5WWA will be active as 407GD from Montenegro on 18-28 June. He will operate SSB on 80-6 metres, possibly also on 2m. QSL via home call, direct or bureau. [TNX IK5WWA]

**4W** - James, 9V1YC and Wilbert, PE7T have been active as 4W/N1YC and 4W/PE7T from Timor Leste (OC-148) since 3 April, and will remain there until 11 April. **5V** - David, OK6DJ and Petr, OK1FCJ will be active as 5V7P from Togo on 21-29 April. They will operate SSB, CW and RTTY with two stations on 160-10 metres. **9M0** - Originally announced for December, the 9M0W DXpedition to the Spratly Islands [425DXN 1345] has been postponed to 10-20 March next year, owing to the unavailability of the resort on Layang Layang. Plans are for Hrane, YT1AD and a large group to be QRV on 160-6 metres CW, SSB and digital modes. The team has two vacant positions. [TNX YT3W]

**9M2** - Luca, IK2PFL will be active holiday style as 9M2/IK2PFL from Perhentian Besar (AS-073) on 1-4 May, and from Langkawi Island (AS-058) on 6-8 May. QSL via home call, direct or bureau. [TNX rsgbiota.org]

**9M8** - Allpa 9M8ADX, Dennis 9W8DEN and Aldrin 9M8WAT will be active as 9M8RC from Satang Besar (OC-165), East Malaysia from around 4 UTC on 29 April until around 2 UTC on 1 May. They will be QRV on 40, 20, 15 and 10 metres. QSL via 9W8KIF.



**9U** - Antonio IZ8CCW, Gabriele I2VGV and a large multi-national team of Mediterraneo DX Club's members will be active as 9U4M from Bujumbura, Burundi on 6-17 November. **C5** - Pedro, ON7WP is active again as C5WP from the village of Buntung (The Gambia) until 9 April. Pedro is actively involved in a private charity organization ([www.SmileGambia.org](http://www.SmileGambia.org)), and his operations are limited to his spare time.



On 5-13 April he will operate mobile on or around 14345, 18145 and 21285 kHz. QSL via ON7WP, direct only. [TNX The Daily DX]

**CE** - A team of seven operators (CA5GRF, CE1DY, CE2MVF, CE3OP, CE5PRD, CE7KF and XQ4NUA) will be active as XR4S on 24-30 April from the mining town of Sewell, a UNESCO World Heritage Site situated at 2,000m a.s.l. in the Andes. QSL via XQ4NUA, direct or bureau.



**CN** - Carlos CT1QP, Helder CT1CDP and Antonio CT1CDU will be active again as CN2CL and CN2DP from Morocco from 21 April to 5 May. Until 25 April they will be QRV on 40 and 20 metres only (around 7070 kHz and 14175 kHz), while touring the Sahara desert. QSL CN2DP via CT1CDP, QSL CN2CL via CT1QP. [TNX Southgate ARC]

**DL** - Mike, DG5LAC will be active as DG5LAC/p from Hooge Island (EU-042) on 29-30 July for the IOTA Contest. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, LoTW, eQSL or via DG5LAC (direct or bureau). [TNX rsgbiota.org]

**DU** - The Ham Radio Communications Group (DX1HAM) will be active as DX75BDM on 8-10 April from the Capas National Shrine (Luzon Island, OC-042). The special callsign honours those who died in the Bataan Death March of April 1942. QSL via operator's instructions.



**DU** - Andy 4F1GNW, Ed 4F1OZ, Gil 4F2KWT and Nani DU1COP will be active as DZ4C from Tinaga Island (OC-202) on 21-23 April. This IOTA group was last activated back in 2003. They will operate CW and SSB on 40, 30, 20, 17 and 15 metres. QSL via VE7DP (Philippine stations can QSL via 4F1OZ). [TNX VE7DP]



**DU** - Dindo, DU1UD will be active as DU1UD/8 from Jolo Sulu (OC-119) starting on 21 April. Operations will be limited to his spare time. At the moment there is no QRT date, and he might remain on the island "for several weeks possibly a month". QSL via M00XO's OQRS; traditional cards via M00XO direct only. [TNX M00XO]

**DU** - Chris, VK3FY has been active as VK3FY/DU8 from Mindanao (OC-130) since 26 April, and will remain there until around 2 May. QSL VK3FY/DU8 via M00XO's OQRS. Chris and others were expected to go and be active as DX8ZWC from IOTA group OC-235 (Mindanao's Coastal Islands), but this operation has been cancelled.



**E3** - Zorro, JH1AJT will visit Eritrea again on 19-29 May. He will be joined by Franz DJ9ZB, Champ E21EIC and Dima RA9USU, with planned activity as E31A on 160-10 metres CW, SSB, RTTY. Zorro also plans to be QRV as E39DI from the Dahlak Archipelago (AF-038) "for a few days" and with a focus on the low bands. This IOTA group was last activated in 1999. **E4** - Janusz SP9FIH, will be active as E44WE from Bethlehem, Palestine on 16-30 May. This will be a reconnaissance trip, with activity limited to 17, 10 and 6 metres. **E5\_nc** - Cezar, VE3LYC is scheduled to arrive in Rarotonga on 10 May and fly to Pukapuka (OC-098) [425DXN 1351] on 11 May at 16 UTC. Hopefully by then he will have been preceded by the "Lady Moana", a boat which is expected to "deliver a lot of cargo" including part of Cezar's equipment. He will be QRV as E51LYC on 40-10 metres SSB and CW. "I have researched and tabled the propagation openings forecasted for the time of this operation, using a solar flux SFI = 80", he says. "I will check these projections against actual propagation conditions once on the atoll, and will adjust the projected openings based on changes in the solar flux". **OK** - Special Czech station OL75SILVERA will be active from 31 March to 14 April to commemorate the 75th anniversary of Operation Silver A, a WWII military operation organized by the Czechoslovak government-in-exile with the assistance of the British Royal Air Force. **SV9** - Seppo, OH1VR will be active as SV9/OH1VR from Crete (EU-015) from 27 April to 3 May. He will operate

mainly CW on 80-10 metres. QSL via home call, direct only. [TNX NG3K]



**T32** - Ken, KH6QJ will be active again as T32AZ from Kiribati (Christmas Island, OC-024), East Kiribati on 11-18 April. He will be QRV on 80, 40, 20, 15 and 10 metres. QSL via KH6QJ. [TNX The Daily DX]


**CLUB LOG'S MOST WANTED LIST** • The latest Most Wanted List, generated on 31 March, is available at <https://secure.clublog.org/mostwanted.php>. The information is derived from QSOs uploaded to Club Log (currently 419 million log entries available for analysis) and, to improve quality, only QSOs that have QSLs confirmed are considered to be worked. The most wanted charts are rebuilt once per month, on average.



**CLUB LOG & LOTW** • "Club Log has become the first logging service to achieve Trusted Partner status for Logbook of the World (LoTW)", ARRL and Club Log announced on 3 April. This means that "we can sign and upload QSOs, or download LoTW matches directly from server to server". **DXCC DELETION OF MIDWAY AND KURE ISLANDS** • On 31 March the ARRL announced that "Midway and Kure Islands have been placed on the list of DXCC deleted entities, effective August 26, 2016". Midway Island (KH4) "had qualified for DXCC status by virtue of its being governed by a separate administration. Because it is now under the administration of Papahānaumokuākea Marine National Monument, however, it becomes a deleted entity". Kure Island (KH7K), a part of Hawaii, "is separated from the rest of the state by Midway; because of that, it qualified for DXCC status under Section II, 2 (b) (iii) of the DXCC Rules - separation from its 'parent' Hawaii. Midway Island's change in DXCC status in turn made Kure Island no longer eligible for DXCC status, since Kure no longer is separated from the rest of Hawaii by intervening land or islands that are part of another DXCC entity". See [www.arrl.org/news/midway-and-kure-islands-are-now-deleted-dxcc-entities](http://www.arrl.org/news/midway-and-kure-islands-are-now-deleted-dxcc-entities). As a consequence of the deletion, the total number of Current Entities on the DXCC List has dropped from 339 to 337, and Honor Roll status will now be attainable after confirming 328 Entities on the List. DXCC members who have affirmed credit with Midway and/or Kure will see their current entity totals drop by two or one points on their DXCC awards. They will also see their DXCC Challenge totals drop commensurately. DXCC wise, contacts made with Midway and Kure after 25 August 2016 will count for Hawaii.



**DXCC YEARBOOK** • The 2016 ARRL DXCC Yearbook, which includes the Clinton B. DeSoto Challenge top scorers and the Annual Listing, can be found at <http://www.arrl.org/files/file/DXCC/DXCCYearbook/DXCC%20YEARBOOK%202016.pdf>. The Annual Listing of DXCC membership contains the call signs and credited totals for new awards and endorsements during the calendar year period from 1 January through 31 December 2016. The DXCC Honor Roll includes those who are within 9 entities of the "current" Entity count for Mixed, Phone, CW, and Digital modes. As of 31 December 2016, there were 339 Entities on the DXCC List, and entry level DXCC Honor Roll was achieved at level 330.

**H44MS** • Bernard, H44MS [425dxn 1335] has moved to a new QTH "in square RI01" (most likely Malaita Island, OC-047), and will remain there until around 10 May. His new location is next to the sea and less noisy than his previous QTH in Honiara, but there is no access to the Internet. European stations who need the Solomon Islands on 80 metres should call Bernard around 3755 kHz between 18.50 and 19.30 UTC: "I am confident I can hear them then, and come back", he says. 
