# DX INFORMATION

**3D2** - 3D2FD is the callsign being used by Dave, WJ2O from Fiji until 16 July [425DXN 1413]. He operates CW on 40-15 metres. QSL via LoTW or direct to N2ZN.



**3DA** - 16-28 September are the dates for HA5AO's operation from Mbabane, eSwatini (Swaziland) [425DXN 1409]. In his free time Pista will be active as 3DA0AO on 80-10 metres CW, RTTY and FT8. Log search and OQRS will be available at <https://www.ha5ao.com>. His plans

include testing a new feature of the PDXG QSL Management Platform, the uploading of QSOs in real time. QSL via OQRS (preferred), or via home call. The complete log will be uploaded to LotW six months after the DXpedition. While in-country he will travel to rural areas visiting villages, schools and orphanages to deliver school supplies. He is interested in making a long term donation agreement to pay school fees for several orphaned children. Pista is paying all expenses from personal funds. Any donations received through his website will be used only for humanitarian purposes. [TNX K5GS]

**4S7** - Dariusz, SP9DLM will be active as 4S7DMG from Kalkudah, Sri Lanka (AS-003) on 6-14 August. He will be QRV on 40, 20, 15 and 10 metres. QSL via home call.

**4W** - Gordon, K7TRB is active as 4W6VA from Dili, Timor Leste (OC-148) until mid-September. In his spare time he will operate mainly FT8, with some SSB and CW, on 20, 17 and 6 metres. QSL via LoTW, or direct to home call.



**7X** - Afif, 7X2RO and others have been active as 7V9A from the Habibas Islands (AF-094) since 17 July, and will remain QRV until the 21st. QSL direct to Ben Lagha, 18

**9H** - Look for 9H3XSV (G3XSV), 9H3TKF (G3TKF) and 9H3AXX (G4AXX) to operate SSB and CW from Malta (EU-023) on 25-29 July. They will participate in the IOTA Contest as 9H6YB (QSL via G3SWH). [TNX G4AXX]



**9M** - A large number of special event stations located in various Malaysian states and federal territories will celebrate the 61st anniversary of Malaysia's independence (31 August 1957) from 1 August to 1 September. Active from West Malaysia will be 9M61MA, 9M61MB, 9M61MC, 9M61MD, 9M61MJ, 9M61MK,

9M61MM, 9M61MN, 9M61MP, 9M61MR, 9M61MT, 9M61MW and 9M61MY. Active from East Malaysia will be 9M61MQ (Sarawak) and 9M61MS (Sabah). QSL via operator's instructions. A certificate will be available from the Malaysian DX and Contest Group's website (<http://www.9mdxc.com/cq9m>).



**9X** - The Italian DXpedition Team, who will be active from Rwanda on 26 September-10 October [425DXN 1413] has added a second callsign. They will use 9X0Y exclusively on

**A3** - Hardy, DL7JLL will be active as A35JLL (requested callsign) while island hopping in Tonga between early August and mid-September. He will be QRV on 40, 20, 15 and 10 metres, running 5-10 watts from "remote islands" and up to 50 watts "when sufficient energy can be supplied". He will start from Nuku'Alofa (Tongatapu, OC-049) on 8-15 August, followed by the Vava'u group (OC-064) until 30 August, then the Ha'apai group (OC-169) until 14 September, and again Tongatapu until 19 September. QSL via DL7JLL, bureau or direct. [TNX DX News]

**BY** - Lide Zhang, BI8CKU and Rui Li, BI8DJW will be active as B0/BI8CKU from Lhasa, Tibet on 6-14 August. They will operate FT8 only on 40 and 20 metres. QSL via LoTW, or via home call.

**CT7** - Special event station CR5F will be active on 16-22 July for the 37th International Motorcycle Rally in Faro, Portugal. Expect activity on 80-6 metres SSB, CW, RTTY and FT8. QSL via CT1EHX.

**FO/A** - K4UEE, K5PI, W5MJ, W5RF and W5SJ will be active as TX5T from Raivavae (OC-114), Austral Islands on 13-21 August. Plans are to operate three stations on 40-6 metres CW, SSB, RTTY and FT8 DXpedition Mode. See <http://australs2018.com/> for more information. QSL via MOURX's OQRS (direct or bureau); traditional QSLs direct only to MOURX.

**G** - Commemorating five decades of offshore radio broadcasting, the Martello Tower Group (<http://www.martellotowergroup.com/gb5rc.html>) will be QRV again as GB5RC on 2-6 August. Activity will take place from the MV Ross Revenge, home of Radio Caroline, moored in the Blackwater estuary near Bradwell-on-Sea (Essex). QSL via GB5RC (bureau) or G6NHU (direct).

**GU** - Mek, SP7VC will be active as MU/SP7VC from Guernsey (EU-114) on 5-11 August, followed by a short activity as MJ/SP7VC from Jersey (EU-013) on 11-14 August. The route for direct QSLing "is currently under discussion".

**JW** - SP3FGI and others will be active as JW100PUT from



Spitsbergen (EU-026), Svalbard on 18-31 July. The special callsign celebrates the 100th anniversary of the Amateur Radio Club (SP3PET) of the Poznan University of Technology. They will be QRV on 80, 40, 20, 2 metres and 70cm

**PY0F** - Renner, PY7RP will be active as PY0F/PY7RP from Fernando de Noronha (SA-003) on 13-16 July. He plans to use FT8 on 80 and 6 metres (50313 kHz). QSL via Club Log's

**SM** - Eric, SM1TDE is active as SJ1SOP from Gotland Island (EU-020) for the Sea Of Peace Award until 31 July. QSL via home call, LoTW and eQSL; logsearch on Club Log.

**VP6D** • "The Ducie Island 2018 project is on schedule", the team reported on 22 July, and "the fundraising campaign is underway" (see the progress on <https://www.vp6d.com/>). VP6D will use the same equipment as KH1/KH7Z. On 20 July the Baker Island radio equipment was returned to Elecraft for inspection, testing and refurbishing. The equipment will be shipped to New Zealand on about 15 August, then Z L3CW will transfer the shipment to the 'Braveheart'. "There's no question that the Baker team had considerable success with FT8. However, a large percentage of the callers weren't prepared for the challenges of this new mode". One of VP6D's announced goals is an "extensive digital operation" using RTTY and FT8, so it is essential to read and understand the latest revision of the 'FT8 DXpedition Mode

User Guide', which is now available in several different languages at <http://physics.princeton.edu/pulsar/k1jt/wsitx.html>. "It will be in everyone's best interest if callers use the most recent software version, correctly configure their equipment, call VP6D above 1000 Hertz and in the correct sequence. If you are unsure of your configuration please seek assistance before calling".

## WRTC 2018

The World Radiosport Team Championship, held in Germany in parallel with the IARU HF World Championship, is now history. Gedas Lucinskas (LY9A) & Mindis Jukna (LY4L) are the new world champions; Manfred Wolf (DJ5MW) & Stefan von Baltz (DL1IAO) are the runners-up, and the bronze medalists are the defending champions Chris Hurlbut (KL9A) & Daniel Craig (N6MJ).

Awards were also given to the SSB Leaders (VY2ZM & KK6ZM), the CW Leaders (ES5TV & ES2RR), the Multiplier Leaders (again ES5TV & ES2RR), the Accuracy Leaders (OR2F & ON5RA), as well as the Best Youth Team (YO8TTT & UT5GW).

The competing teams were assigned special callsigns in the Y2A-Y9Z block (not used since the dissolution of the German Democratic Republic, which the block had been allocated to), and knew their callsigns at 11.45 UTC on 14 July, i.e. 15 minutes before the contest started.






