



The aim of this annual event is to promote worldwide interest in the Antarctic continent. Special callsigns (QSL via operator's instructions) are expected to be aired during this year's AAW from the following countries: Australia (VK2ANT), Austria (OE16AAW, OE88WAP, OE89ANT, OE90AAW), Belgium (OR16ANT), France (TM16AAW, TM16WAP, TM1ANT), Italy (II2ANT, II5ANT, IO5SP, IR18AAW, IR1ANT, IR4ANT, IV3BOVE), Netherlands (PA6ANT, PF19ANT), Poland (SP0ANT), Spain (AO1WAP), Ukraine (EM16UAP), USA (K4A, K4K, KB0ANT). 
