

DX INFORMATION



4X - Special callsigns 4Z64EURO, 4X64S, 4X64O, 4X64N and 4X64G will be active from 18 April to 18 May for the 64th Eurovision Song Contest

that this year will take place in Tel Aviv, Israel (14-18 May). QSLs via LoTW and eQSL; certificates will be available for download at <https://www.iarc.org/livelog/> (see 4Z64EURO on qrz.com for the rules).

5T - Evert, PA2KW will be active as 5T2KW from Nouadhibou, Mauritania on 5-19 April. Guest operating from 5T5PA's QTH, he will use CW and maybe some SSB. QSL via Club Log's OQRS (preferred) and LoTW.

5W - Uruguay DX Group's members Gus CX2AM, Bert CX3AN and Rainer CX8FB will be active holiday style from Upolu, Samoa (OC-097) on 1-10 June. They will operate mainly CW and SSB on 80-6 metres. Callsign and QSL route to be announced in due course. [TNX CX3AN]

5X - Anders, SM0HPL is active again as 5X7W from Kampala, Uganda until 27 April. In his spare time he operates FT8, JT65 and CW (QRP). QSL via LoTW or direct to home call; logsearch on Club Log. [TNX DX World]

DU - Owing to a case of homonymy that resulted in a





E5_sc - Bruce AD7MM (E51BAS), Doug W6HB (E51DLD) and Marilyn KI7DLK (E51MAS) will be active holiday style from Rarotonga (OC-013), South Cook Islands on 21-28 April. QSL via operator's instructions. [TNX The Daily DX]

G - The RSGB National Radio Centre will run special event station GB2DAY on 10-14 April. This is to celebrate a new exhibition at Bletchley Park (<https://bletchleypark.org.uk/>) entitled "D-Day: Interception, Intelligence, Invasion" which explores Bletchley Park's top secret impact on the planning and implementation of D-Day 75 years ago. QSL via eQSL only.

G - The Cray Valley Radio Society will be active as GB4DFI on 13-14 April to commemorate the life of Owen Cross, G4DFI, who passed away on 29 November 2018. They will operate SSB and CW on 80-10 metres with two stations. QSL via Club Log's OQRS or LoTW. Owen was a Vice President of the Society and their QSL Manager for over twenty years. He handled cards for G3RCV and M8C (including MJ8C and MM8C IOTA DXpeditions) and 29 special event stations organised by the Society, as well as a number of G0VJG's DXpeditions. [TNX M0MCV]



G - GB0GKA (operated by Tony, G3ZRJ) and GB0GKB (operated by Larry, G4HLN) will be representing Portishead Radio during this year's Maritime Radio Day. The event will run from 12 UTC on 14 April until 22 UTC on 15 April. Portishead Radio (callsign GKA), the world's largest and busiest radiotelephony station, provided worldwide maritime communications and long-range aeronautical communications from 1928 until 2000. The Maritime Radio Day is being held annually to remember the nearly 100 years of wireless service for seafarers (see <http://www.trafficlist.net/mrd/> for more information).

G - G4EDG, G4ELZ and G4GSA will be active as GB5SM from St Mary's, Isles of Scilly (EU-011) on 20-27 April. They will operate CW, SSB and digital modes on the HF bands. QSL for this operation via LZ1JZ (direct), via Club Log's OQRS, and LoTW. [TNX NG3K]

GD - Hiro JF1OSL as MD0HWX, Toru JH0CJH as MD0ITP, and Shin JR1NHD as MD0IUX will be active holiday style from the Isle of Man (EU-116) from 27 April to 1 May. They will operate SSB, CW and digital modes on 40-10 metres. QSL MD0ITP via JH0CJH (direct or bureau); QSL MD0IUX via JJ2VLY (direct only). Plans are to upload the logs to LoTW and Club Log.

GJ - A team of eight Belgian operators will be active as GJ6EFW from Jersey Island (EU-013) from 30 April to 5 May. They will operate mainly SSB with some CW and FT8 on the HF bands and 6 metres. QSL via ON6EF (direct or bureau) and eQSL; they will not use LoTW.



GJ - Look for MJ0ILB (home call OK1BIL), MJ0IKL (home call OK1DOL), MJ/OK1FIK, MJ/OK1FWM, MJ/OK1NP

and MJ/OK3RM to be active from Jersey (EU-013) on 19-28 July. They will operate SSB, CW and digital modes on the HF bands, with some activity on 6 and 2m. They will participate in the IOTA Contest as MJ0ICD (QSL via OK1DOL, direct or bureau).

HS - To mark the coronation of King Rama X, the Radio Amateur Society of Thailand will be operating special event station HS10KING from 1 May to 31 July. On 3-6 May activity will take place as HS10KING/mm from the Royal Thai Navy aircraft carrier, the "Chakri Narubet", in the Gulf of Thailand. The station will be QRV on 40, 20, 15 and 10 metres, as well as on 2 metres and amateur radio satellites, including the Es'hail 2/QO-100 satellite. All QSOs will be confirmed automatically via the bureau.

J2 - Chris, EA3NT will be active as J20NT from mainland Djibouti on 13-14 April [425DXN 1456], while waiting for the rest of the J20DX team to arrive. In order to avoid clashing with the KH8 expedition FT8 frequencies, he will operate Fox & Hound mode on 3577, 7061, 10141, 14085, 18104 and 21090 kHz (usual frequencies for 12, 10 and 6m). 
OH0 - Mart, DL6UAA will be active as OH0UA from the



Col, MM0NDX and Jonathan, MM0OKG reported on 16 April that their "radio equipment was impounded by customs at the Djibouti-Ambouli International Airport upon arrival", despite the fact that the third operator (Christian, EA3NT/J20NT) had cleared customs "smoothly" two days earlier.

On 17 April, being still unable to retrieve their bags, the team decided to cancel their planned activity from Sept-Freres (AF-059) "due to time constraints", and to use Christian's equipment from Moucha Island (AF-053).

On 18 April "at 0700 local we departed the mainland for the 40 minute crossing to Moucha Island", they posted to the DXpedition's website (<https://j20dx.com/news/>). "We identified an excellent location for radio upon arrival and immediately assembled a 15m VDA and 17m & 20m vertical dipoles. Our intention was to add more antennas as the day progressed.

Literally 5 minutes before the first CQ from AF-053 we received a phone-call from National Security saying signatures were needed for the authorization letter to permit us to collect our impounded gear. This same letter would also allow us to depart Djibouti without anymore issues at airport customs. However, we had to return to the mainland to get the letter.

The weekend is Friday and Saturday here in Djibouti meaning this would likely be our final chance of obtaining the important authorization letter prior to heading home.

Before we had even started, teardown begun. Yes, we left the island 2 hours after arriving. AF-053 is now also cancelled. Upon returning to the mainland we headed straight to the National Security offices. Yes, you guessed it - no authorized letter to be seen. We had basically been told fake news. We've now had enough of this country and look forward to heading home".

JX7GIA • Ken, LA7GIA was on Jan Mayen (EU-022) on 4 April for about five hours. This time included selecting the QTH, installing and taking down all gear and antennas. He was active as JX7GIA and made 630 CW QSOs on 20 metres in four hours. "I really felt like winning a powerball lottery when I was allowed a free seat at the 3 hour Military flight going from Oslo Military airport directly to Jan Mayen", he says. "I have been discussing this possibility with the Military for about 5 years. They have regular flights going to Jan Mayen, but there are very rarely available seats both ways, and one also need a special invitation to be allowed to enter this military flight. They let me know the day before that there was an opportunity. It was a big surprise to me as I almost had given up this possibility a long time ago". 

THE FT4 PROTOCOL FOR DIGITAL CONTESTING



The following announcement was posted by Joe Taylor, K1JT to the WSJT software development mailing list on 22 April:

"Soon after the 'FT8 Roundup' held on December 1-2, 2018, we started serious work on a faster, more contest-friendly digital mode that can compete with RTTY-contesting QSO rates while preserving many of the benefits of FT8. The result is FT4 - a new digital mode specifically designed for radio contesting.

Over the past month a small group of volunteers have been conducting on-the-air tests of FT4. The early tests were very successful and helped us to make a number of important design decisions. We believe FT4 has considerable promise for its intended purpose.


