DX INFORMATION

Owing to the ongoing and fluid nature of the COVID-19 situation globally, announced activities might be cut short, postponed, cancelled or even extended at any time and without notice.

4U1UN - 4U1UN has been active again since 11 April. As part of the Stay Home movement, during the UN HQ building lockdown, the United Nations Radio Club has been granted special permission to utilize a very limited remote operation possibility. Considering the demand for digital modes for 4U1UN, operation will be limited to FT8 mode only. The operator at the keyboard is James, K2QI. QSL via LoTW, or via HB9BOU (direct or bureau).



4W - The Lagunaria DX Group's DXpedition to Timor Leste (11 October-8 November) [425DXN 1505] has been postponed until sometime in 2021. "The current situation based on the Corona pandemic makes it impossible to plan anything later in this year", the team says. "The uncertainty of travel safety, the not predictable impact on the companies we have to rely on and the current restrictions that prevent a solid preparation, forced us to take this step. We hope that we can see clearer by the end of this year what will be in 2021". Updates will be posted to <http://timor-leste-dx.de/>.

4X & LY - Special call signs 4Z0GAON from Israel (QSL via LY2QT) and LY300GAON from Lithuania (QSL via LY2QT) will be active on 1-30 April to commemorate the 300th anniversary of the birth of Eliyahu ben Shlomo Zalman, known as the Vilna Gaon (1720-1797), one of the most influential figures in rabbinic study since the Middle Ages. A certificate will be available, see qrz.com for information.



5H - Charles, 5H3DX (NK80) expected to leave the country on 21 March [425DXN 1502], but he has changed his plans due to the COVID-19 situation. Although "we have not had a large outbreak", he says, "I believe there is more good to be done by remaining in Tanzania, especially since our usual caretakers are prevented from traveling at this time. I also think I am safer in the long run". QSL direct to home call.

5G - Matteo, IZ4YGS will be active again as 9G5GS from Sanzule, Ghana from 14 April to 15 May. In his spare time (typically 21-00 UTC, and sometimes also 12-14 UTC) he will operate FT8 (Fox & Hound only on 3567, 7056, 10131 and 14090 kHz) and SSB on 160-10 metres. He also plans some USB activity on the QO-100 Geostationary satellite. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, LoTW, eQSL, or direct to home call.

A3 - Stan, LZ1GC will be active as A35GC from Tonga (OC-049) from 19 October to 2 November. He will operate CW, SSB, RTTY and FT8 on 160-6 metres. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, LoTW, or via LZ1GC (direct or bureau). See <http://www.c21gc.com/> for QSLing policy and other information.



A6 - The Emirates Amateur Radio Society (EARS) has several "StayHome" stations active to raise awareness for social distancing and sheltering in place during the COVID-19 pandemic: A60SH/1 (operated by A61M, QSL via A61BK); A60SH/2 (operated by A61Q, QSL via EA7FTR); A60SH/3 (operated by A61NN, QSL via A61NN); A60SH/4 (operated by A61BK, QSL via A61BK); A60SH/5 (operated by A61DD, QSL via A92AA); A60SH/6 (operated by A61QQ, QSL via A61BK); A60SH/7 (operated by A61FJ, QSL via LZ1YE); A60SH/8 (operated by A61K, QSL via A61BK); A60SH/9 (operated by A61AY, QSL via A61AY); A60SH/10 (operated by A61FK, QSL via A61BK). CE0Y - Hans-Martin, DK2HM plans to be active holiday style as XROYHM from Easter Island (SA-001) from 27 August to 7 September. He will operate SSB and digital modes on 80-10 metres. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, LoTW, eQSL, or via DK2HM (direct or bureau). Updates will be posted to Twitter (@xr0yhm).



CT8 - Celebrating his 82nd birthday, Antonio, CU8AS will be active as CQ82AS on 1-7 May. He is a resident on Flores Island (EU-089), Azores. [TNX CT4NH]

E6 - Stan, LZ1GC and Ivan, LZ1PM will be active as E6AM from Niue (OC-040) from 28 September to 17 October. They will operate CW, SSB, RTTY and FT8 on 160-6 metres with two stations. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, LoTW, or via LZ1GC (direct or bureau). QSLing policy and other information can be found on <http://www.c21gc.com/>.



EA - EE1MGY is a special call sign for EB1LO to commemorate throughout April the sinking of the RMS Titanic during her maiden voyage (15 April 1912). He will operate CW, FT8 and WSPR on 160 metres - see why on qrz.com. QSL via EB1LO, direct or bureau.



EA - Celebrating World Amateur Day and IARU's 95th anniversary, ten special call signs will be active on 15-30 April: AM95WARD, AM1WARD, AM2WARD, AM3WARD, AM4WARD, AM5WARD, AM6WARD (Balearic Islands), AM7WARD, AM8WARD (Canary Islands) and AM9WARD (Ceuta & Melilla). QSL via EA4URE (bureau preferred). See <https://iaru95.ure.es> for the OQRS and the IARU 95th Anniversary Award.

In addition, all Spanish radio amateurs are allowed to use special prefixes during the same time frame:

EA stations can use AO + call area + 95 + suffix: e.g. AO395PP = EA3PP

EB stations can use AM + call area + 95 + suffix: e.g. AM795R = EB7R

EC stations can use AN + call area + 95 + suffix: e.g. AN595AHA = EC5AHA

EU - Commemorating the end of World War II, special callsigns EV75M, EV75F, EV75K, EV75P, EV75GA, EV75GK and EV75PP are expected to be active from Belarus on 2-9 May. They will participate in the Memorial Pobeda-75 (see below). QSL via operator's instructions.

F - The Association Promotion Radio Amateur du 62 (F4KLR) will be active as TM18JUIN in May (8-9, 23-24 and 30-31) and June (6-7, 13-14, 18-21 and 27) to commemorate the 80th anniversary of the "Appeal of 18 June" made by Charles de Gaulle from the BBC in London. All QSOs will be confirmed automatically via the bureau and eQSL; direct requests via F4AHN. Often regarded as the origin of the French Resistance against the occupation during World War II, the appeal is one of the most remarkable pieces in the history of radio broadcasting, and as such it has been inscribed to the UNESCO's Memory of the World Register.

G - GB0NHS is a special callsign for United Kingdom stations to use in appreciation of the National Health Service (NHS), the publicly funded healthcare system which is "at the forefront of saving lives in the war against COVID-19". Operating schedules and QSL information will be posted to <https://www.qrz.com/db/GB0NHS>. Also active with the same intent are GB8NHS (see qrz.com for QSL information) and GB5NHS (QSL via LoTW only) from Northern Ireland.

G - Peter, G4XEX will be active as GB4SAH (Stay At Home) on 8-30 April to help amateurs "pass the time during the lockdown".

G - Members of the Bury Radio Society (G3BRS) will operate as GB9WYH From 13 April until 11 May. The special callsign, whose suffix stands for Wash Your Hands, is being activated to raise awareness and reinforce the message that washing hands will save lives during the COVID-19 pandemic. Moreover, the UK regulator (Of-



com) is "happy for radio amateurs to add /NHS to the end of their call signs" if they want to show their support for the National Health Service.

G - Members of the RAF Amateur Radio Society (<https://www.rafars.org/>) will be active as GB75VED on 1-28 May to commemorate the 75th anniversary of VE Day. QSL direct to 2E0NDZ.



G - RSGB Contest Club's members will be active as GB1945PE, GB1945PJ and GB75PEACE on 1-31 May and again on 1-31 August as part of the VE Day and VJ Day celebrations. Look for activity on the HF bands and 6 metres SSB, CW and digital modes. QSLs via LoTW and eQSL only; five awards will be available, see <https://www.rsgb.org/ve-vj-marathon> for information.

G - This year the Poldhu Amateur Radio Club (GB2GM) will be unable to operate from the Marconi Centre on 25 April. Another special callsign, however, will celebrate Marconi's birthday: GB1GM, operated by Cliff, G3UYN (Chairman of PARC). "No QSL", he says.

G - Even though this year's International Marconi Day has been cancelled, three IMD stations will be active from England on 25 April to celebrate the birth of Guglielmo Marconi: GB5IMD (on 2m FM), GB6IMD (on the HF bands SSB) and GB8IMD (on the HF bands FT8). QSLs via eQSL only, but certificates will be available: see "2020 Innovation Awards" on the Quantum

Amateur Radio & Technology Society's website (<https://quantumtech.club/>).

GM - Euan, MMOVIK is active as GB1COR from his home QTH on Mainland, Shetland Islands (EU-012) for the month of April in recognition and support for "the health professionals and essential key workers" during the coronavirus emergency. Apparently QSL cards will not be available for this special callsign.

H4 - Bernhard, DL2GAC has been active as H44MS from Malaita (OC-047), Solomon Islands since 7 February [425DXN 1499]. He expected to leave the country on 23 April, but all of his flights have been cancelled. H44MS will be QRV "for some more time" on 17 and 40 metres SSB and FT8. [TNX DX World]

HA - The Hungarian Amateur Radio Society (MRASZ) has joined the Stay at Home campaign with five special callsigns whose suffixes form the popular motto: HG20ST, HG20AY, HG20AT, HG20HO and HG20ME. Look for activity on 160-10 metres CW, SSB and digital modes from 15 April until 15 May. QSLs via LoTW or via the bureau. An award will be available for working each callsign on two different modes: see <http://www.mrasz.org/stay-at-home/award-rules>.



HL - Special callsigns HL40GDM and D73M will be active on 1-31 May to commemorate the 40th anniversary of the Gwangju Uprising (18-27 May 1980), aka the Gwangju Democratization Movement. QSLs via HL4CCM, direct or bureau. In 2011, the Archives for the May 18th Democratic Uprising against Military Regime were inscribed to the UNESCO Memory of the World Register.



HR - Gerard, HR5/F2JD expected to remain in Honduras until 4 April [425DXN 1491], but the COVID-19 situation is causing him to stay longer. Unless he can catch a "flight opportunity", he is likely to be there until early June. QSL via F6AJA. [TNX F6AJA]

I - I15MPI is the special callsign for the Mediterraneo DX Club's Pisa District to celebrate its 10th anniversary on 1-30 April. QSL via LoTW. See qrz.com for more information.

JA - Special callsign 8J17CALL will be activated from 23 April until 22 April 2021 by the 7-CALL Amateur Radio Club (JS1YFY), a Tokyo based club station that gathers operators with callsigns in the 7K-7N prefix series - "a symbol of the golden age of Japanese amateur radio history". The first 7K call (7K1AAA) was issued on 23 April 1990, the last 7-Call was issued on 20 June 2003 (7N4XZZ). Over the years some 95% of the 7K-7N stations lost interest in the hobby, and nowadays the 7-Callers are only 17,583 out of the 402,180 Japanese amateurs. See <https://7-call.com/en> for more information. All QSOs will be confirmed automatically via the bureau, eQSL and LoTW.



JA_ant - The 61st Japanese Antarctic Research Expedition's overwintering team at the Syowa Station on East Ongul Island (AN-015), Antarctica includes Taka, JA1AGS and Hiro, JH7JCX. In their spare time they are QRV from the 8J1RL club station, with activity on 40, 30, 20, 17 and 15 metres mainly FT8. They will be there until Janu-

ary 2021. QSL via the bureau to 8J1RL, or direct to JG2MLI.

LA - The Norwegian National Guard's Radio Amateur Club (LA1V) has been granted permission to use the special callsign LN1V throughout 2020 to mark the 75th anniversary of the liberation of Norway at the end of World War II (8 May 1945). QSL direct to LA4LN. [TNX OPDX Bulletin]

LZ - Special callsign LZ50BFRA will be active from 26 April until the end of the year to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the Bulgarian Federation of Radio Amateurs. Founded on 26 April 1970, BFRA is the national IARU member society. QSL via LZ1BJ (bureau).



OE - Austrian special event station OE20M will be active on 24-26 April to commemorate the anniversary of Guglielmo Marconi's birth (25 April 1874). QSL via OE1WHC (bureau) or direct to DokuFunk, OE20M, An den Steinfeldern 4A, 1230 Wien,

Austria.



OE - 4U2STAYHOME is the special callsign for the VIC Amateur Radio Contest DX Club (4U1A, <http://www.cqdx.ru/4u1a/>) to join the Stay Home /Stay Safe campaign. This activity counts for Austria for DXCC, and for the Vienna International Centre for the CQ DX Marathon. QSL via UA3DX,



direct or bureau.

OE - Jo, OE4VIE will be active as OE50MHZ (WWL JN87dc) from 1 May to 30 June. He will operate CW, SSB and digital modes on 6 metres, to mark the 30th anniversary of the allocation - initially subject to severe restrictions - of the Magic Band to Austrian amateurs. QSL via LoTW and eQSL; paper QSLs will be sent automatically via the bureau.



direct or bureau.

OH - "Pysy kotona" means "stay at home" in Finnish. Ten OH#PYSYKOTONA special callsigns with OH0 to OH9 prefixes are active from 4 April until 3 July to raise awareness for social distancing and remaining at home during the COVID-19 pandemic. The activity is coordinated by the Lahti Amateur Radio Club (<http://www.oh3ac.fi/>). QSL via LoTW, eQSL, or via OH3AC.

OH - The Finnish Amateur Radio League (SRAL) is responsible for another series of ten special callsigns, from OH0STAYHOME to OH9STAYHOME. SRAL encourages to use a temporary Q-code (QSH, for Stay Happy & Healthy) during contacts made during this "Stay Home Project", to be run from 8 April through 8 July. QSL via OH2BAD. A number of awards will be available. Information on the project can be found on <https://www.sral.fi/2020/04/07/finland-stay-home/>.

OZ - Special call signs 5P0WARD and 5P0WHD will be active on 18 April in celebration of World Amateur Radio Day. A special award will be available for contacts made

with 5P0WARD/xx and 5P0WHD/xx stations with different suffix extensions; see <https://www.qrz.com/db/5p0ward> for complete information. QSLs via Club Log's OQRS, LoTW and eQSL, or via OZ1ACB.

PA - Vincent, PE2V will be active as PE75BORNE until 4 April 2021 to celebrate both the 75th anniversary of the liberation of the city of Borne during World War II (3 April 1945) and the 75th anniversary of the VERON, the Dutch IARU society which was founded on 21 October 1945. He will operate SSB, FT8 and FT4 on 80, 40, 20, 10 and 2 metres. QSL via PE2V.

PY - PT2ADM will be active as ZW75FEB from 1 April to 31 May to celebrate the 75th anniversary of the end of World War II, and as a tribute to the Forca Expedicionaria Brasileira, the Brazilian Expeditionary Force that fought alongside the Allied powers in Italy during the conflict. QSL via PT2ADM, direct or bureau.


SP - SN0KURP is a special callsign for Radio Club Baza (SP5KVV) to promote the Polish ethnic region of Kurpie from 5 April to 31 May. QSL via the bureau.

TA - The Turkey Radio Amateur Club's branch of Subesi (YM3KB) will be active as TC100KIDS on 1-30 April to mark the National Sovereignty and Children's Day (23 April).

UA - A very large number of Russian stations using special prefix RP75 (where the letter P stands for 'pobeda', i.e. 'victory') will be active on 2-9 May to celebrate the 75th anniversary of the end of World War II. See <https://pobeda.srr.ru/stations/> for the list of participating stations and their QSL routes.



VE - Radio Amateurs of Canada (RAC, Canada's IARU member society) will hold a special on-air event to celebrate World Amateur Radio Day on 18 April, from 12.00 UTC to 23.59 UTC. The event is to encourage as many amateurs as possible to get on the air and contact as many RAC stations as possible. The RAC official stations that will operate across Canada are VA2RAC, VA3RAC, VE1RAC, VE4RAC, VE5RAC, VE6RAC, VE7RAC, VE8RAC, VE9RAC, VO1RAC, VO2RAC, VY0RAC, VY1RAC and VY2RAC. A special commemorative certificate will be available. See <https://www.rac.ca/operating/world-amateur-radio-day-april-18/> for more information.



VE - The Grassroots Amateur Radio Club (VO1GRC) will be active as XN1BOA between 25 April and 25 May to commemorate the 75th anniversary of the end of the Battle of the Atlantic. QSL via operator's instructions

VE - Canadian licensees are allowed to use "special event" prefixes from 20 April to 20 June as a reminder to stay at home and help contain and limit the spread of COVID-19: VA stations can use CF, VE stations can use CG, VO stations can use CH, and VY stations can use CI.

VK - The Wireless Institute of Australia will celebrate World Amateur Radio Day and the society's 110th anniversary for six months starting on 17 April at 14 UTC. WIA official stations that will operate across Australia are VI110WIA, VK1WIA, VK2WIA, VK3WIA, VK4WIA,



VK5WIA, VK6WIA, VK7WIA and VK8WIA. QSL via LoTW and eQSL; a commemorative certificate will be available for contacting one or more of these special event stations.



VK - VI250COOK is a special event callsign granted to the Cairns Amateur Radio Club (VK4CNS) for use from 1 May to 31 August. It commemorates the 250th anniversary since Captain James Cook and the HMS Endeavour charted the East Coast of Australia, sailing from what is now Sydney to what is now Cooktown.

W - The Great South Bay Amateur Radio Club of Baby-

lon, NY is looking for amateurs in each of New York State's 62 counties to operate their home stations under the special event callsign K2H (H for Heroes) between 1 and 31 May. All operators will be signing K2H/ along with the county abbreviation as used in the New York QSO Party (e.g. K2H/SUF for Suffolk, K2H/NAS for Nassau, etc). This special operation is intended to express gratitude to the men and women on the front lines of the

COVID-19 pandemic. "Confirmation certificates" will be available, but QSL cards will not be issued. See <https://www.grz.com/db/k2h> for more information.

YB - ORARI Daerah Jawa Tengah will join the Stay Home campaign and be active as 8C2WFH from 20 April to 19 May. The special callsign's suffix stands for Work From Home. Look for activity on 80, 40, 20,



15 and 10 metres CW, SSB and digital modes. See <https://oraridaerahjateng.or.id/8c2wfh/> for more information

YO - Members of the Federatia Romana de Radioamatorism will use special callsign YO19STAYHOME from 15 April to 15 September. QSL via LoTW and eQSL. See <http://www.hamradio.ro/yo19stayhome/en/index.php> for information about the certificate.

ZL - The New Zealand Association of Radio Transmitters (NZART) has been granted approval by Radio Spectrum Management to treat the COVID-19 lockdown period as a "special event." This means that, for the duration of the lockdown, New Zealand amateur radio operators are allowed to replace their ZL prefix with ZM.







This version has new features as well as corrections for defects found since TQSL 2.5.1 and TQSL 2.5.2 were released. TQSL 2.5.3 can be installed to upgrade any older version. On all three supported platforms (Windows, MacOS and Linux), installing TQSL 2.5.3 will replace older versions of Trusted QSL while preserving your Callsign Certificates, Station Locations, and preferences.

He will start immediately to work with Randy on processing the results of last month's WPX SSB Contest, and will take the reins for next month's WPX CW Contest.

COVID-19 IMPACT



The COVID-19 situation is affecting postal systems worldwide. International mail from several countries is not operational right now, as airlines have suspended their postal deliveries. Think twice before mailing direct QSL card requests, and be patient if your coveted cards do not show up - the QSL managers are most likely waiting for the service to resume.

Also, several IARU member-societies have announced that they are unable to receive shipments of QSL cards for their bureaux during the current emergency. Before sending shipments of cards to a national QSL bureau, the IARU strongly recommends an inquiry to the member-society to confirm that the package can be accepted.




