




DX INFORMATION



3B8 - 3B8M will be QRV from Mauritius (AF-049) during the CQ WW DX CW Contest (M/M category) and a few days before and after the contest (22 November-1 December). The operating team includes G0CKV, KX7M, M0CFW, M0SDV and W6NV. «We will bring a microphone this time», G0CKV says, «and M0SDV might try some low-band SSB to hone his pile-up skills and good humour, and we might possibly also do some FT8 on the low bands». QSL 3B8M and 3B8HA via LoTW and M0OXO's OQRS; QSL 3B8/KX7M via F5CWU's OQRS (<http://www.f5cwu.net/oqrs/>) and hopefully LoTW; QSL 3B8/M0SDV via LoTW and Club Log's OQRS; QSL 3B8/M0CFW via LoTW, Club Log's OQRS or via home call; QSL 3B8/W6NV via home call.

4X - The *Land of Craters* programme sees four special stations operate from the Makhteshim ("craters") in the Negev desert of Israel. The first two activities were conducted by 4X0ARF (November 2020) and 4X0GDL (April-May 2021). Look for 4X0KTN to be QRV on various bands and modes with two stations from Makhtesh Hakatan (Small Crater) on 12-13 November. QSL via 4X6ZM (direct or bureau), LoTW and eQSL. A certificate will be available for working three out of four special stations: see <https://www.iarc.org/craters/>. [TNX 4X6ZM]

5H - Vladimir, OK2WX will be active as 5H3WX from Zanzibar (AF-032) from 10 November to 3 December. He will operate CW and SSB on 80-10 metres. QSL direct to HA3JB.

6Y - Lester, W8YCM will be active again as 6Y6Y from Jamaica (NA-097) starting on 28 November until sometime in January. QSL direct only to home call.

9N - Robert, S53R is now stationed in Kathmandu, Nepal for the foreseeable future, and will be active as 9N7AA (reissued callsign, previously used by UA3AA in 2014). He is waiting to move to a permanent residence and for part of his equipment to arrive; «for the time being only limited operation is planned», he says, «but the pace should pick up by end of November». QSL via LoTW, or direct to S57DX.



A4 - Celebrating the Sultanate of Oman's 51st National Day, members of the Royal Omani Amateur Radio Society (ROARS) will operate special callsign A451ND on 18-25 November. QSL via M0OXO's OQRS.

A5 - Peter, HB9DVG (G4ENL) will be working in Wangdue Phodrang, Bhutan between 17 November and 21 December, and will try and operate SSB and FT8 on the HF bands as A52CC when time permits. «Poor location» he says, «but let's try. I am a novice with FT8, so have patience». QSL via N4GNR.

A6 - Celebrating Oman's National Day (18 November), special event call sign A60OMA will be active on 12-18 November. QSL via EA7FTR.

A9 - Celebrating the Kingdom of Bahrain's 50th National Day, members of the Bahrain Amateur Radio Society (BARS) will operate special call sign A950ND on 1-16 December. QSL via EC6DX.

C6 - A team of six (AA7JV, KN4EEI, N1DG, NA7RY, W6IZT and W8HC) plans to be active as C6AGU from Wood Cay (NA-001), Bahamas for the CQ WW DX CW Contest (27-28 November) and the ARRL 160 Meter Con-

test (3-5 December). Between the two contest weekends they will operate CW, SSB and FT8 with a focus on the low bands. They will be using six "Radio In a Box" (RIB)



stations - see <https://www.qrz.com/db/c6agu>. QSL via LoTW, Club Log's OQRS, or via HA7RY. [TNX The Daily DX]

C6 - Brian, ND3F will be active as C6AAQ from New Providence Island (NA 001), Bahamas from 24 November to 7 December, including an entry in the CQ WW DX CW Contest. QSL via EA5GL. [TNX NG3K]

C9 - Elvira, IV3FSG has been active as C92R from Mozambique since 14 November, and will remain there until 30 November. Usually she operates SSB and digital modes on various bands in her spare time. QSL direct to IK2DUW.

CX - Radio broadcasting in Uruguay began on 6 November 1922, when Radio Paradizabal went on the air for the first time. Starting on 6 November 2021, Radiogrupo Sur will be active as CW100A in celebration of that centenary. QSL direct to CX2ABC. More information can be found on <https://cw100a.radio.org.uy/>.

E7 - Celebrating Statehood Day of Bosnia and Herzegovina (25 November), special callsign E7BOSNIA will be active from the ancient royal cities of Bobovac, Visoko and Jajce on 14-28 November. QSL via the bureau. See <https://www.qrz.com/db/E7BOSNIA> for more information.

EA - The Union de Radioaficionados de Leon (EA1URL) will operate special callsigns AM1111D, AM1111E, AM1111I, AM1111L, AM1111N, AM1111O and AM1111R on 1-19 December in celebration of the 1111th anniversary since the establishment of the ancient Kingdom of Leon, now part of the autonomous community of Castile and Leon within the modern Kingdom of Spain. EA6 - Roger, EA3M will be active as EA6/EA3M (QSL via EA3M) from Ibiza, Balearic Islands (EU-004) on 23-30 November. Main activity will be during the CQ WW DX CW Contest as EA6FO (QSL via EA3AIR). [TNX The Daily DX]



F - F1PHB, F5BQU, F5TLZ, F6BGH and F8EFU will be active as TM57STN (Saint Nicholas, 2-16 December), TM57MC (Merry Christmas, 12-26 December) and TM57HNY (Happy New Year, 29 December to 12 January). QSL via F-11734, direct or bureau. [TNX F8REF]

FJ - Dario, KP4DO will be active as FJ/KP4DO from St. Barthelemy (NA 146) on 19-24 November. He will be QRV mainly on 20 metres, but also 40, 17 and 10 metres «as propagation permits». QSL direct to KP4DO.

FM - Dimitry, UT5UGR will be active as FM/UT5UGR from Martinique (NA 107) from 22 November to 2 December, including an entry in the CQ WW DX CW Contest as T07A. QSLs via LoTW, Club Log's OQRS, or via UT5UGR. [TNX UT5UGR]

FS - John K9EL, Paul K9NU, Bob W9AP, Mike W9MK and Marco FS4WBS will be active as T09W from Saint Martin (NA-105) on 1-10 December, including an entry in the ARRL 160 Meter Contest (3-5 December). They will operate CW, SSB, FT8 and some RTTY with three stations. «The team's primary focus will be on 160, 80



and 40 metres during hours of darkness», they say, but «we will also operate 30 through 6 depending on openings». QSL TO9W via LoTW, Club Log's OQRS (preferred), or via W9ILY. Certificates will be awarded for several categories of most band-modes worked. G - Celebrating Saint Andrew, patron saint of Scotland, the Welland Valley ARS will be active as GB0SA between 6 November and 3 December. QSL via G4XEX, LoTW and eQSL.

G - Chris, G4LDS will be active as GB4LDM on 20-28 November. The special callsign is for Lancashire Day, held on 27 November to commemorate the day in 1295 when Lancashire first sent representatives to attend the Parliament of England. QSL via G4LDS, direct or bureau.

GM - On 12 December 1921 the very first personal message transmitted over the Atlantic from amateur to amateur was received in Scotland by Paul Godley (2ZE), who had travelled to the UK as the representative of the ARRL. The successful Transatlantic Tests of 1921 were a milestone that heralded the dawn of two-way international amateur radio communication.



In celebration of this historic centenary, the Crocodon Rock Amateur Group, based near Arrossan (Scotland), will be active as GB1002ZE and GB2ZE on 1-26 December. More information: <https://www.transatlantic.org.uk/>.

HA - Special event station HG5PLANET will be active from 16 November until 16 December for the "Planet Budapest 2021 Sustainability Expo and Summit". QSL via eQSL. [TNX HA5BA]

HB9 - Celebrating the the 100th anniversary of the historic Transatlantic Tests of December 1921, members of the HB4FR Amateur Radio Club will be active as HB1BCG on 1-31 December (1BCG was the callsign of the Connecticut station whose message crossed the



Atlantic Ocean to be received in Scotland). QSL via HB9ACA.

HI - Kasimir, DL2SBY will be active holiday style from the Dominican Republic on 1-14 December. He will operate CW, FT8 and possibly some SSB as HI7/DL2SBY from Punta Cana (NA-096) and Bayahibe (NA-096). During the second week he might go on a one day side trip to Saona Island (NA-122), and be active as HI2/DL2SBY. QSL via LoTW, or direct only to home call or Club Log's OQRS. He no longer uses the bureau.

HR - Gerard, F2JD will be active again as HR5/F2JD from Copan, Honduras from 8 December to 5 April 2022. He will operate CW, SSB and digital modes on the HF bands. QSL via F6AJA (direct or bureau); logsearch on <http://LesNouvellesDX.fr/voirlogs.php>. [TNX Les Nouvelles DX]

I - Special callsign II6MI will be in use between 20 November and 20 December for the centenary of the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier (Milite Ignoto), which contains


VE - Also celebrating 100 Years of Transatlantic Amateur Communications, the York Region Amateur Radio Club will be active as CF3BP between 13 November and 12 December. 3BP was the call sign of Edward Rogers Sr., who was the first Canadian amateur to successfully transmit a transatlantic radio signal from Newmarket (Ontario) to Androssan (Scotland).



VE - Special call sign VX3INSULIN will be active on 1-31 December to mark the 100th anniversary since a team of researchers at the University of Toronto discovered insulin. The operations will be primarily digital, with FT8 and FT4 being the dominant modes of use. QSL via VE3NOO (direct or bureau) and eQSL.

VP8_ant - Sebastian, SQ1SGB expects to be active again as VP8/SQ1SGB from Halley VI Research Station, Antarctica (AN-016) between early December and 31 January 2022. He will be QRV mainly on 40 metres SSB and FT8. QSL via EB7DX. [TNX The Daily DX]

This will apply from 1 to 26 December and does not require any individual authorisation. 2ZE was the US callsign of Paul Godley, who went to the UK and took part in the tests as the representative of the ARRL.



3Y0J: BOUVET ISLAND DXPEDITION NEWS • «We're currently working on a winch system that will assist us with bringing equipment from the beach up the 5-10m cliff at Cape Fie. We have identified 3 different access points on the cliff that all have different grades and properties, as such we have 3 possible routes to the camp. We plan for climbing the small cliff by bolting a route and access it with ropes, if a ladder can not be used. We will install the winch on the top of the cliff which will make it easy to lift all the equipment including bulky generators, antennas, tents, fuel and other stuff. We will have an electric winch system, but also possibility for non-electric operation. As well traditional ropes to lift parts. Rune LA7THA was in South America last week, and he brought with him parts from HK to be used on Bouvet. These parts and the system we look into is well proven and tested with far heavier loads than we plan to lift at Bouvet. We will construct and test the complete winch system in Norway in the following months. Follow our journey to Bouvet!». [Posted by

The shortage of gasoline in the country prevented them from using a generator, so they had to resort to car batteries. Logsearch on Club Log; QSL via eQSL and LoTW only, apparently paper cards will not be available for this brief operation.



CROZET 2022-2023 • The DXpedition to the Crozet Islands is now on Twitter: <https://twitter.com/crozet2022>. Thierry, F6CUK has been granted permission to be QRV from the #3 Most Wanted DXCC Entity for three months (mid-December 2022 to mid-March 2023) [425DXN 1591]. «It seems important to indicate some of the conditions of this permission», he says, as there are «three aspects that impose limitations»: climate (the wind blows almost constantly at 70 kmh), soil nature (it is impossible to secure any mast in the ground), and nature protection (for bird protection, antennas, guy wires and anything that



could be an obstacle are forbidden; also, it is impossible to dig, make anything in concrete, all over the island).

«Our original request was for 4 squares on 40 and 20. This was refused. Impossible to keep them up because of the wind and the soil nature. The only possibility that the administration allowed was to have an attachment point to an existing building, and have wire antennas from there. NO beam! This is clearly stated in the permit we received. The whole team is studying the best solution for the best antenna possible, taking into account these constraints». Thierry also adds that «CW and SSB will be the priority. FT8 will be mostly for low bands if we can install an 80m dipole, and for far away areas (US West Coast mainly)».

The Northern California DX Foundation (<http://www.ncdxf.org/>) has announced it is granting USD 20,000 to Thierry: «hopefully this experienced DXpedition operator can exploit this rare opportunity to access Crozet Island, put out an effective signal on all the bands and log all of the needy over the course of his extended stay».




W8S: SWAINS ISLAND 2023 • «This week the W8S team had another conference call about the planning for the upcoming DXpedition to KH8/s Swains Island», Ronald PA3EWP wrote on 4 November. «Due to the Covid-19 restrictions, it will remain impossible to travel to American Samoa in the coming months.

The limited number of flights, only 5 the first quarter of 2022, from Hawaii to American Samoa with the additional restriction to do a Covid-19 test 5 days before departure in Hawaii makes travelling extreme difficult. Also tourists have a lower priority to buy a ticket. The risk is too great to travel to Swains in the spring of 2022. Two members of our team are also part of the 3Y0J Bouvet team scheduled for November/December 2022.

The entire team therefore had to decide to postpone the W8S Swains DXpedition until March 2023.

This is the only opportunity to be on Swains for 15 days with the same team as our original plans in 2020. Our project has certainly not been canceled but postponed to the spring of 2023. 




