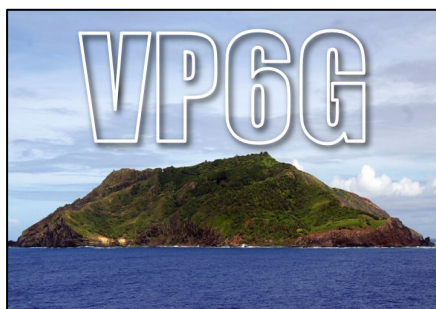
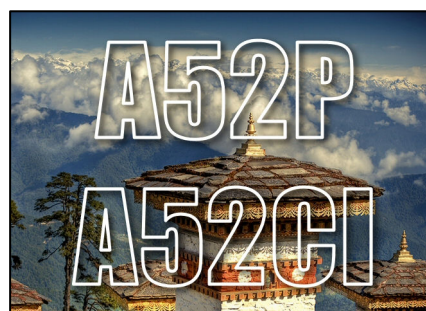

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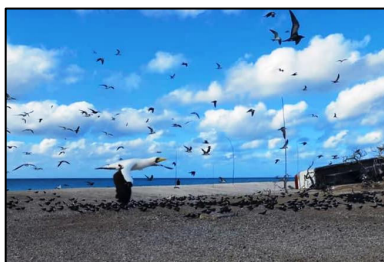

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DX INFORMATION



3D2_cr - 3D2AJT went QRT earlier than planned, on 17 April, as the Rebel DX Group is preparing a second operation from Conway Reef, which is expected to start soon under the

callsign 3D2CCC. This will be a 2-man activity on 160-6 metres SSB (one station), CW (two stations) and FT8/FT4 (twelve stations). QSL via Club Log's OQRS. Bookmark <https://www.facebook.com/rebeldxgroup/> for updates.

5X - Jack, NP2OR has been active as 5X3L from Kayabwe («just a few steps from the equator line»), Uganda since 20 April, and will remain there until sometime in May. He will be QRV on 20, 10 and once in a while on 40 metres. QSL via LoTW, or direct via Club Log's OQRS. Updates will be posted to <https://hamradiosafari.blogspot.com/>.

9H - 9H6HE is the special callsign for the Malta Amateur Radio League (9H1MRL) to celebrate the swearing in of Dr. Myriam Spiteri Debono as Malta's 11th President. Look for activity from 15 April to 31 May, on 40, 20, 15 and 10 metres SSB, CW and digital modes. QSL via LoTW; paper QSL cards will not be available.

9X - Harold, DF2WO will be active again as 9X2AW from Rwanda on 2-17 May. He will operate CW, SSB and digital modes on the HF bands and 6 metres. QSL via M0OXO's OQRS. [TNX The Daily DX]

A5 - Janusz, SP9FIH and Leszek, SP6CIK will be active from Bhutan as A52P and A52CI, respectively, from 19 April to 4 May. They will operate SSB, CW and digital modes on 40-6 metres. Their QTH is located at about 3000 metres a.s.l., with a good short path opening to North America, Europe and Japan. QSLs via Club Log's OQRS. A6 - In recognition of World Amateur Radio Day, the Emirates Amateur Radio Society will operate special callsign A60WARD (QSL via EA7FTR) between 15 and 24 April. CE0Y - Ben DL6FBL, Win DK9IP and Lutz DM6EE will be active as 3G0YA from Easter Island (SA-001) from 18 April to 6 May. They will operate SSB, FT8 and CW on 160-6 metres. On FT8 they will be using MSHV software («stay above 1000 Hz when calling/working us»). QSL via Club Log's OQRS (preferred), or via DJ4MX. Plans are to enable Club Log's Live

CN - To celebrate World Amateur Radio Day and the 99th anniversary of the founding of the IARU, special callsign CN99HR will be active on 13-21 April. QSL direct to CN8RAH.



CT - Special event stations CS2GPDx (continental Portugal), CR2GPDx (Azores) and CR3GPDx (Madeira) will be active on 1-31 May to celebrate the 30th anniversary of the Portuguese DX Group. QSL only via LoTW. A large number of

certificates and trophies will be available, see <https://www.qrz.com/db/CS2GPDx> for detailed information. [TNX CT4NH]

EA - Celebrating the 75th anniversary of the Unión de Radioaficionados Españoles (URE), Spanish amateurs are allowed to replace their normal prefix from 1 to 31 May as follows: EA stations can use AO#75, EB stations can use AN#75, and EC stations can use AM#75, where “#” is the digit of their call area. For example,



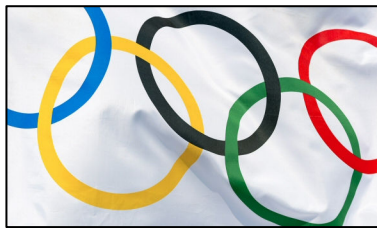
EA1FMJ will use AO175FMJ, EC5BUH will use AM575BUH, EB7KA will use AN775KA.

EA - Once again the Federación Digital EA will operate special callsigns AO1EU, AO2EU, AO3EU, AO4EU, AO5EU, AO6EU, AO7EU, AO8EU and AO9EU on 3-12 May to celebrate Europe Day, the anniversary of the Schuman Declaration (9 May 1950) that paved the way to the European Union. See <https://www.fediea.org/eudota/> for more information. QSL direct to EA3RKF.

F - Dominique, F5PTI will be active as TM500NA on 14-28 April to memorialize the 500th anniversary since the first European explorer, Giovanni da Verrazzano, visited nowadays New York City area and named it New Angouleme. QSL via F5PTI.

F - Special callsign TM83JO will be active for fifteen days between 16 April, when the Olympic flame is lit in Greece, and 26 July, when the flame ends its journey by lighting the Olympic cauldron at the Paris 2024 Opening Ceremony of. Look for activity on 80-6 metres SSB, CW and digital modes, as well as via QO-100. QSL via the bureau, LoTW, eQSL.

F - Special callsign TM13JO will be active on 8-15 May as the Paris 2024 Olympic Torch Relay passes through the French Department of the Bouches-du-Rhône. QSL via F5SDD. Also active during the same time frame are expected to be TM83JO from the Department of Var (8- 12 May) and



TM04JO from the Department of Alpes-de-Haute-Provence. QSLs via operators' instructions.

They will be followed by a large number of other special callsigns, which in the following weeks will cover the progress of the Olympic Torch as it crosses other Departments and Territories until its arrival in Paris on 26 July. The Association des Radioamateurs Vauclusiens (F5KPO) organizes the «Olympic Torch Relay Challenge» for contacts made with those stations - see <https://www.qrz.com/db/TM00JO> for the details, and <https://www.oly24.fr/awardform.html> for the certificates.

FO - Hiroyuki, JI1JKW will be active holiday style as FO/JI1JKW from Bora Bora (OC-067), French Polynesia on 26-30 April. He will operate SSB, CW and FT8 on 40, 20, 17, 15, 12, 10 and 6 metres. QSL via LoTW, or via home call. [TNX The Daily DX]

G - The Wessex DX Group will be active as GB0WED on 20-27 April for Earth Day, the global event held annually on 22 April to demonstrate support for environmental protection. QSL via eQSL.



G - Joining Guglielmo Marconi's 150th anniversary celebrations, the Cornish Radio Amateur Club (GX4CRC) will be active as GB150GM from 27 April until 27 July. QSL via eQSL. This activity participates in the «Marconi 150 Award», organized by the Associazione Radioamatori Italiani (ARI) and the Coordinamento Stazioni Marconiane Italiane (CSMI) under the patronage of the Guglielmo Marconi Foundation. GM - A large group of Camb Hams will be active as GS3PYE from the Isle of Mull (EU-008) from 27 April to 3 May. Look for them on 80-10 metres and QO-100. QSL only via Club Log' OQRS. [TNX G3ZAY]

HB9 - Celebrating the 150th anniversary of the birth of Guglielmo Marconi, members of the USKA's Valais/Wallis Section will be active as HB150GM between April and December. QSL via the bureau to HB9Y.

HR - John, AD8J has been active holiday style as HR9/AD8J from Roatan Island (NA-057) since 6 April, and he will remain there until 28 April. He operates CW, FT4, FT8 and maybe SSB on 80-6 metres. QSL via LoTW, or direct to home call. [TNX The Daily DX]

HV - Members of ARI Civitavecchia, ARI Roma, ARI Perugia and ARI YOTA Italia will be active as HV9TVM on 27 April, from 6 to 12 UTC. They will operate CW and SSB on 40 and 20 metres, and via QO-100 (CW, SSB and FT8). QSL via LoTW, or via IK0PHU. Plans are for HV9TVM to become a permanent amateur radio station located in the building that housed the first broadcasting centre of Vatican Radio, built by Guglielmo Marconi and inaugurated in 1931 by Pope Pius XI. Since 1995, the building has housed Vatican Radio's Technical and Historical Museum.



I - Celebrating the 150th anniversary of the birth of Guglielmo Marconi, members of ARI Montegrappa (IQ3RP) will be active as II3GM from 15 April to 15 May. QSL via operator's instructions.

I - Claudio, IU6RVC and Marcello, IW6PLZ will be active as IL7/IU6RVC and IL7/IW6PLZ from San Domino Island (EU-050) on 19-21 April. QSLs direct to IU6RVC.

I - Celebrating the 150th anniversary of the birth of Guglielmo Marconi, special station II5OX will be active on 20 April (7-15 UTC) from the Ximenian Observatory in Florence. A radiotelegraphic station, which was visited by Marconi, was set up at the observatory as early as 1912. QSL via IW5DPF, direct or bureau.

I - Look for IY0CG, IY0GA (Sardinia), IY0IMD, IY0MMR, IY0ORP, IY0TC, IY1MR, IY1SM, IY1SP, IY1TO, IY4FGM, IY5PIS, IY6GM and IY7M to be active during the International Marconi Day (27 April). QSL via operators' instructions. These stations

are affiliated to the Coordinamento Stazioni Marconiane Italiane which gathers amateur radio stations operating from historic Marconi sites located in Italy (<http://csmi.altervista.org/wp/>).



I - Commemorating the 150th anniversary of the birth of Guglielmo Marconi, members of ARI's Board of Directors will be active as IR2GMCL between 28 April and 27 July during the «Marconi 150 Award». See <https://www.qrz.com/db/IR2GMCL> for the rules. Paper QSL cards will not be provided; electronic QSLs will be downloadable from the HamAward platform.



JA - Take, JI3DST will be active again from the Miyako Islands (AS-079) between 24 April and 26 June. Call-signs to be used are JS6RRR, JS6RRR/6, JI3DST/6, JJ5RBH/6 and JR8YLY/6 on SSB and CW, as well as JS6RRR/p, JI3DST/p, JJ5RBH/p and JR8YLY/p on FT8/FT4. QSOs will be made available for Club Log and LoTW Matching on the IOTA website.

JA - Look for Mitsu, JE1HXZ/6 to be active from Yonaguni Island (AS-024) from 26 April to 5 May. He will operate CW, SSB, RTTY and FT8/FT4 on 160-6 metres. QSL via LoTW (preferred) or direct to home call; bureau cards can be requested by email (details on qrz.com). Similarly active from the same island will be Sam, 7K1EAS, who will be QRV as JR6/7K1EAS from 30 April to 2 May. He will operate FT8 and FT4 on 15, 12 and 10 metres. QSL via Club Log's OQRS.

OE - In celebration of the 150th anniversary of the birth of Guglielmo Marconi (25 April 1874), Enrico, OE7AFT (IZ4AFL) will be active as OE150GM on 19-28 April. He will operate CW only. QSL via LoTW, or direct to OE7AFT («neither SASE nor USD/EUR required»).

OE - Sylvia, OE5YYN and others will be active as OE20SOTA between 1 May and 31 October to mark the 20th anniversary since Austria joined the Summits on the Air programme. A certificate will be available, see <https://www.qrz.com/db/OE20SOTA>.

OJ0 - Bjorn LA1UW, Tor LA3WAA, Kristoffer LB0VG, and



Stian LB5SH will be active from Market Reef (EU-053) from 27 April to 4 May. OJ0T will be their main call-sign, but they will also use OJ0/homecall from time to time. They will Operate SSB, CW and FT8 on 160-6 metres

ON - OT2024EPIC is the special call-sign for the Antwerp Port Contest Club (ON8APC) to promote the seventh edition of the Antwerp Port Epic cycling race. Look for activity between 19 April and 19 May (the actual day the race will be held on).

ON - Members of Club Radio Durnal (ON4CRD) will be active as OR90AL on 1-31 May. The special call-sign marks 90 years since the death of Albert I, King of the Belgians, who died in a mountaineering accident at the age of 58. QSL via the bureau.

OX - Bo, OZ1DJJ will be active again as OX3LX from Greenland between 26 April and 9 May. In his spare time he will operate FT8, RTTY and CW from Kangerlussuaq (grid GP60), Nuuk (grid GP44) and Paamiut (grid GP51). QSL via OZ0J; QSOs will be uploaded to LoTW and Club Log.

T8 - Nobu, JA0JHQ will be active again as T88PB from Koror (OC-009), Palau on 12-15 April, with main activity during the CW leg of the Japan International DX Contest (from 7 UTC on 13 April to 13 UTC on 14 April, <http://jidx.org/>). QSL via LoTW (preferred), or direct to JA0JHQ.

TT8 - Six operators of the Italian DXpedition Team (Franco I1FQH, Alfeo I1HJT, Tony I2PJA, Silvano I2YSB, Angelo IK2CKR and Stefano IK2HKT) will be active as



TT8RR (SSB, CW and RTTY), TT8XX (FT8) and TT8TT (call-sign for QSOs via QO-100) from Chad on 17-30 April. They will run four stations on 80-6 metres, plus one station dedicated to satellite. Operations will start on

FT8 (F/H at first, and normal mode on standard frequencies when the pileup decreases), other modes will follow. The hottest period of the year approaches (temperatures expected to reach 43 degrees Celsius in the shade) and the team has already taken measures by procuring an additional backup power generator, as the on-site generator will not be able to run 24/7. CASS AWARDS • The Cass Awards honour the wisdom and spirit of Cass WA6AUD (SK), and encourage DXpeditions to maximize the number of DXers worked with a Plaque for the single-operator DXpedition that works the most unique callsigns during a 2-week interval, and a Plaque for the "unlimited" DXpedition that works the most unique callsigns during a 4-week interval, with no limit on the number of operators of the activity.

Dmitry "Dima" Zhikharev, RA9USU has won the 2023 Single-Operator Cass Award by working 13,784 unique callsigns (a new record) during his **7073T** operation from Socotra Island in Yemen.

The 9X5RU team (Slav Rodin OK8AU, Nick Tolkunov R5EC, Vasily Pinchuk R7AL, Mike Alekseev RU3UR, Leo Berezhnoy RW9JZ and Victor Filimonov UA3QLC) worked 40,959 unique callsigns from Rwanda, setting a new record to win the 2023 Unlimited Cass Award.

In addition to the RIBs, a lot of our gear is built by us, specifically designed for remote operation where reliability is key».

The **station configuration** has been finalized. There will be six RIB stations on the island. Four stations are set up to be remotely operated via Starlink and the Internet by an experienced team of 24 operators from 8 countries, while two stations will be operated locally (from the boat) by AA7JV, HA7RY, N1DG, KN4EEI and the newly added team member Adrian, KO8SCA.

IOTA & POTA: «Jarvis is one of the rarest of the IOTA counters, having been off the air for 34 years. It is needed by 82% of IOTA program participants. Because of the requirements set by the permit of the USFWS, while the stations, antennas and power are all set up on Jarvis Island, the local operators must conduct the DXpedition from the MV *Magnet* which will still be in the Jarvis Island National Wildlife Refuge, just offshore. Both the IOTA and POTA programs have agreed to recognize QSOs made by the local operators, but will not allow QSOs made by internet remote operators to count. Therefore **QSOs made by AA7JV, HA7RY, N1DG, KO8SCA and KN4EEI will count for IOTA OC-081 and POTA K-0115**. Daily uploads by the N5J team to Club Log will identify the operators. Additionally, at the beginning of each operator shift the team will endeavor to post on the cluster the callsign of the operator so chasers have some real time notice. At this time, all phone operations are expected to be by the at island team as well, giving that mode 100% IOTA/POTA certainty.
