3D2 - Aki, JA1NLX will be active as 3D2YA from Mana Island (OC-121), Fiji on 3-9 October. He will operate mainly CW on 30-10 metres. QSL via JA1NLX (direct only) and LoTW. An OQRS for direct and bureau cards will be available at Club Log (bureau cards will be sent through Global QSL).

4K - Dmytro, UT6UA and Alex, UT5UAS will be active as 4K/UT6UA and 4K/UT5UAS from Azerbaijan (grid LN30gk) between 16 and 20 June. They will concentrate on working EME on 144 MHz (main mode JT65).
