4K - Owned, organised and regulated the European Olympic bv Committees, the European Games is a multi-sport event whose first edition will take place in Baku, Azerbaijan on 12-28 June. Several special callsigns (4J15EUG, 4J1EUG, 4J2015BAKU,

ÀJG1EU, , 4K15EUG, 4K2015BAKU, 4K2015EUG) are expeted to be active throughout June to mark this event. QSL routes and information on the "Odlar Yurdu" award can be found on grz.com.

4W - James, 9V1YC and Wilbert, PE7T are active as 4W/N1YC and 4W/PE7T from Timor Leste until 16 June. They operate CW and SSB on 80-10 metres. QSL 4W/N1YC via W5UE and LoTW; QSL 4W/PE7T via PE7T (bureau) and LoTW. [TNX QRZ-DX]

It is estimated this DXpedition will incur costs of over 200,000 USD (plus individual and personal expenses). Support has been already from many Foundations, Clubs and received individuals, but on 25 June the team reported to be "about 30,000 USD short of our need for the next payment November 1st. 


