3Y0Z: BOUVET 2018 • "Our fund-raising began about this time last year, so we have been at it for 12 months", the 3Y0Z team wrote on 22 August in their Press Release #7. "We are extremely grateful for the excitement, encouragement and actual contributions that have come our way. It has truly been amazing to see how the DX community has stepped up to help 'make this happen'.

We believe that we have negotiated a contract with our transportation partners that gives us a good idea of what our costs will ultimately be. This expense represents most of our overall costs. Regarding the remainder of our budget, cost control is a daily challenge and a priority for leadership and the team. We take it very seriously.

However, recently we made a couple of changes affecting the expense side of our equation. This accounts for a small 3% increase in our overall costs, but will make life on Bouvet safer and more comfortable. We have decided to add a second operating shelter and a third leeping shelter. This will allow us to have more room to place our 14 one-KW stations (12 HF and 2 EME) and to separate the operating modes. This will make our 14-16 estimated days of 24/7 operating more comfortable and less challenging. The bottom line is we have a small percentage increase in costs, but the on-island benefits are well worth the extra expense.

In summary, looking at our income from the Operating Team itself, the DX Foundations, DX Clubs and individual DXers worldwide and our estimates of what our costs will turn out to be, we feel we are in a good and enviable position... but we are still short over \$100,000.

I have confirmed with Tanzania Communications Regulatory Authority (TCRA) that both 5H3 calls are not currently registered calls. The signals are clearly coming from Southern Europe".

R24RRC • Already used on 15-19 July from Baidukov Island (AS-114), this callsign was active again from 31 July to 3 August from Bol'shoy Shantar Island (AS-044). QSL via Club Log's OQRS (search for R24RRC_AS044), traditional cards via R7AL (direct).

+ SILENT KEYS + Boris G. Stepanov, RU3AX (ex-UW3AX) passed away on 28 July at the age of 76. Known as the "father of competitive radio" in the former USSR, in 2016 he was inducted into the CQ Hall of Fame as a "leading Russian amateur, deputy editor of Russian Radio magazine; pioneer of computerized contest logging and log-checking; developed prototype for World Radiosport Team Championships (WRTC); first to propose 'glass cockpit' for ham transceiver, combining frequency readout and spectrum scope on front panel display". He also participated in the first three 4J1FS DXpeditions to Malyj Vysotskij (1988, 1989 and 1991). Jean J. Lewuillon, ON8RA/5TOJL passed away on 8 August. Born in 1928 and first licenced in 1960 as F3JL, he was also active as 9Q5LJ (1965-1967) and 9X5AB (1980-1983). Special callsigns in Mauritania included 5T0ITU, 5T1FOC, 5T1MM, 5T2MM and 5T3MM. A top-notch CW operator, he conducted his personal campaign

against split operating: "simplex CW is not a disease, nor a mental defect", he said, "it's the lifestyle of the real telegrapher who does not need subtleties to exercise his art!"

Recently reported Silent Keys also include Heinz Marhoff (**DK8DY**), Anatoly L. Shikov (**ER5AL**) and Relen V. Osmolovsky (**R6KO**, ex UU5JO and UB5JO), one of the doyens of amateur radio in Crimea.


