DX INFORMATION

9A - 9A164T is the special callsign for members of the Radio Klub Novi Bokanjac (9A1ZDR) to commemorate the birth of Nikola Tesla (10 July 1856) on 10-12 July. QSL via the bureau and eQSL.

9A - Members of the Radio Club Croatian Flora Fauna (namely 9A2HW, 9A2MF, 9A2NA, 9A3DF, 9A3ST and 9A6AA) will be active as 9A0FF from Dugi Otok Island (EU-170) on 22-29 July. QSL via 9A2MF. [TNX NG3K]



A6 - A60EMM is a special callsign commemorating the "Норе Emirates Mars Mission Probe" (https://www.emiratesmarsmission.ae/), which is ex-



pected to be launched from the Tanegashima Space Center in Japan between 20 and 22 July, depending on improved weather conditions. The Hope orbiter is scheduled to reach Mars in February 2021, to coincide with the 50th anniversary of the United Emirates' Arab formation. Look for A60EMM to be QRV

with multiple stations, e.g. A60EMM/1 A60EMM/2, A60EMM/3, etc: https://www.grz.com/db/a60emm.

BV - Bruce, BV2KI will be active as BV0WPX from Liuchiu Yu Island (AS- 155) on 25-26 July. OSL via BV2KI and LoTW. [TNX NG3K]

BY - Look for members of the One Partner DX Club, BG4OP to be active from Lingshan Island (AS-150) on 25-26 July. QSL via BI4IIZ. [TNX NG3K]

CT - Four members of the Portuguese DX Group (namely CT1EEQ, CT1EGW, CT1FPA and CT4NH) will be active

DL - Mike, DG5LAC will be active as DG5LAC/p from Hooge Island (EU-042) on 24-28 July. He will operate SSB and FT8. OSL via Club Log's OQRS, or via DG5LAC.

DL - Jo, DL5KUD will participate in the IOTA Contest from his home QTH on Ruegen Island (EU-057). He will operate CW in the 12-hour category. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, or direct only to DL5KUD. [TNX NG3K]



DU - DZ30SH is the special callsign for the Ham Society of the Philippines (DX3H) to join the Stay Home campaign. Look for activity until 29 August, with Boy, 4F3OM as primary operator. QSL via LoTW and eQSL.

F - Fabien, F4GYM will be active as F4GYM/p from Noir-

moutier Island (EU-064) in late July. He will operate SSB, CW and digital modes. QSL via home call. On 25-26 July he will be signing F6KBK/p (QSL via the bureau to F4GTB). [TNX NG3K]

F - Radio club F4KKE at Saint-Martin-des-Besaces (Nor-



mandy) will operate CW, SSB and digital modes as TM11AD from 31 July to 3 August to commemorate the role played by the British 11th Armoured Division during Operation Bluecoat (July-August 1944). QSL via

Club Log's OQRS, LoTW, or via the bureau to F4KKE. G - A number of Denby Dale Amateur Radio Society's



members will each be running a special event station on 1 August to celebrate Yorkshire Day: GB2YD, GB4YD, GB5YD, GB6YD, GB8YD, GB8YDS and GB9YDS. Also taking part in the celebrations will be the Pontefract & District Amateur Radio Society as GB0YD, and the Wakefield & District Radio Society as GB0YDS.

OSL via operator's instructions. **G** - Two special event stations will be active in August to mark the critical role that radar played in the Battle of



Britain 80 years ago. GB80BRS will be operated to commemorate Bawdsey Radar Station in Suffolk, which was the location of the world's first operational radar station. GB80CH will be operated from Chelmsford

in Essex, which has the most complete surviving radar tower from the Battle of Britain; the callsign's suffix stands for Chain Home, the codename for the ring of coastal early warning radar stations built by the Royal Air Force.

HA - The Hungarian FIRAC group is active as HA70MAV until 1 December in celebration of the 70th Railway Day. The special callsign's suffix stands for Magyar Allamvasutak, "Hungarian State Railways". QSL via LoTW and eQSL only.

HB0 - Loick, HB9HBY and Greg, HB9TWU will be active as HB0/HB9HBY (QSL via EB7DX) and HB0/HB9TWU (QSL via EB7DX) from Liechtenstein on 24- 26 July (but look for a special callsign to be used on 25 July). They plan to operate SSB, CW and FT8 on 80-6 metres.



HS - Look for E20WXA/p (QSL direct to home call), HS0YNM/p (QSL via home call,

direct or bureau, and LoTW), HS1OLQ/p (QSL via home call) and HS2JQC/p (QSL via Club Log's OQRS, LoTW, or direct to home call) to be active from Si Chang Island (AS-107) between around 6 UTC on 11 July until around 8 UTC on the 12th. They will operate SSB, CW, FT8 and FT4 on 40, 20, 15 and 10 metres.

I - Franco will be active again as IL7/IK4YCO from San Domino Island (EU-050) on 4-10 July. He will operate SSB on 40-10 metres. QSL via home call, direct or bureau. The log will be uploaded to LoTW and Club Log. [TNX IK4YCQ]

I - Michele, IU2NKC will be active as IA5/IU2NKC from Isola del Giglio (EU-028) on 12-25 July. QSL via home call (bureau), LoTW and eQSL.

I - Ignazio, IT9AGZ is active as IT9AGZ/IE9 from Ustica Island (EU-051) on 21-31 July. He operates SSB on 40,

20 and 15 metres. QSL via home call. [TNX IK2RLS]

 ${\bf I}$ - Giuseppe, IT9PPG will be active as IF9A from Favignana Island (EU- 054) on 25-26 July. QSL via IT9ATF.

I - Raffalele, IH9YMC will participate in the IOTA Contest from his home QTH on Pantelleria Island (AF-018). QSL only via LoTW or eQSL; he also uploads his log to Club Log on a regular basis.

ISO - Emil, DL8JJ will be active as ISO/DL8JJ/m from Sardinia (EU-024) on 16-26 July, with a side trip to Foradada Island (EU-165) on 18 July. He will operate CW and SSB on 40-10 metres. QSL via DL8JJ and LoTW. [TNX DX World]

JD1_oga - Takashi, JH1FFW will be active from the Ogasawara Islands (AS-031) on 15-19 July. He will operate SSB and FT8 on 40-6 metres. QSL via LoTW, eQSL, or the bureau to home call. [TNX DX World]

LA - Tom, LA4LN is now active as LN1V from Stord Island (EU-055, Locator JO29qs) until mid-August. He is QRV mainly on 6 metres using digital modes, although he can operate on all bands and modes. QSL direct to home call. [TNX OPDX Bulletin]



LA - Nick, LB9LG is active as LMOPOMOR for the annual Pomor Festival (22-26 July) on Vardo Island (EU-141). QSL via LB9LG (direct or bureau), and LoTW.

LZ - During the IARU HF World Championship, LZ0AA

will be the Bulgarian Federation of Radio Amateurs' HQ station on 80 metres. It will use the tallest antenna (215 metres) at the Vakarel Transmitter broadcasting facility, inaugurated in 1937 and shut down on 31 December 2014. The antenna will be taken down shortly after the contest. QSL via the bureau to LZ1BJ. The other BFRA HQ stations will use LZ0HQ.

OH - Tony, OH1TD is active again from his summer QTH on Korpo Island (EU-096) until September. QSL via home call, direct or bureau.

OH - Jukka, OH3OJ will be active as OH3OJ/1 from Kaurissalo Island (EU- 096) from 30 July to 5 August. He will operate CW, FT8 and some SSB on 80-6 metres. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, LoTW, or via home call (bureau preferred).

OX - Bo, OZ1DJJ will be active again in his spare time as OX3LX from Aasiaat Island (NA-134) on 7-30 July. He will be QRV on 40-4m. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, LoTW, or via OZ0J.

PA - Special event station PI75VERON will active from 1 August to 31 December to celebrate the 75th anniverary of Vereniging voor Experimenteel Radio Onderzoek in Nederland (VERON), the Dutch IARU society which was founded on 21 October 1945. QSL via PA1AW.





PY - Carlos PY1CG, Marcelo PY1MT and Renato PY8WW will be active as ZV1M from Ilha Juruaiba (SA-029) on 24-26 July. Their original destination was Ilha das Palmas

(SA-079), but they had to change their plans due to bad weather forecast. They will operate CW, SSB and digital modes on 80, 40, 20, 15 and 10 metres. QSL via PY1MT.



PZ - Markus, DJ4EL expects to be active as PZ5G from Papegaaien Island (SA-092) on 16-19 October. He will operate CW and SSB on 80-10 metres. Before and after that, between 11 and 25 October, he will be active as PZ5GE from Houttuin (mainland Suriname) on 40-10m SSB. QSLs via LoTW, Club Log's OQRS, or via home call, direct or bureau. Follow him on Twitter (<u>https://twitter.com/rapanuiman</u>) for the latest news.

SM - Kjell, SM4DDS will be active again as 7S5A from Stora Alo/Boko Island (EU-177) on 19-24 July. He will operate CW, SSB and FT8 on 80-6 metres. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, LoTW, or via home call (direct or bureau). [TNX SM4DDS]



SP - Special event callsign SN87LOT is active on 1-31 July to commemorate the 87h anniversary of the ill fated



flight of Lithuanian pilots Steponas Darius and Stasys Girenas. On 15 July 1933 they attempted a nonstop flight from New York City, United States to Kaunas, Lithuania in a small airplane named "Lituanica". After suc-

cessfully crossing the Atlantic Ocean, they crashed on 17 July when thy were only 650km short of their final destination. QSL via SP1PMY.

SV - Markus, DJ4EL, will be active as SV8/DJ4EL from Kythira Island (EU-113) on 26-30 July. He will operate SSB on 40-10 metres. QSL via LoTW, Club Log's OQRS, or via home call. [TNX DX World]


SV5 - Stathis, SV5DKL will participate in the IOTA Contest from his home QTH on Rhodes Island, Dodecanese (EU-001). He will operate CW. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, LoTW, eQSL, or via home call. [TNX NG3K]

Granite Island (OC-228) on 12 July between 1 and 6 UTC. He will operate CW on 20 and 15 metres with 100 watts (battery powered) and a ground plane. Access is limited to daytime hours only, and he will not be able to overnight on the island. QSL via Club Log's OQRS.

Members of the IARU Administrative Council and the three IARU regional executive committees will send a signal report plus AC, R1, R2 or R3, as appropriate.

Back in April the RSGB Contest Committee decided that to minimise the impact of COVID-19, the IOTA Contest in 2020 is exclusively for Single Operators using their home stations: only "SO Fixed Island" stations and "SO Fixed World" stations will be eligible to compete in this year's event. However, **any island station will count for the island points and multiplier**, even if that station is not in the competition. Moreover, IOTA Ltd has confirmed that "**island contacts made over the weekend will count for its IOTA Programme in the normal way**".

The IOTA Contest will be held from 12 UTC on 25 July until 11:59 UTC on 26 July, on 80, 40, 20, 15 and 10 metres CW and/or SSB. Complete details can be found on the RSGB Contest Committee's website: https://www.rsqbcc.org/hf/rules/2020/riota.shtml.


