## DX INFORMATION

Owing to the ongoing and fluid nature of the COVID-19 situation globally, announced activities might be cut short, postponed, cancelled or even extended at any time and without notice.

4X - Look for special prefixes $4 X 73$ and $4 Z 73$, followed by the station's individual suffix (e.g. 4X1VF and 4Z1AR will be signing $4 X 73 V F$ and $4 Z 73 A R$ respectively) to be used to celebrate the State of Israel's 73rd anniversary on 14-17 April, an especially during the Holyland Contest (https://www.iarc.org/iarc/\#HolylandContest). [TNX 4X1VF]


8Q - Mats, RM2D (SM6LRR) will be active holiday style as 8Q7MS from the Maldives (AS-013) from 28 March to 10 April. He will operate CW with some SSB on mainly 40-15 metres. QSL via LoTW, or EA5GL.
9J - Bodo, HB9EWU expects to be active as 9J2BG while speding one year on a humanitarian mission at the St. Paul's Mission General Hospital in Kashikishi, northern Zambia. QSL via home call (direct or bureau); note that requests will be processed when he is back home in 2022.


A2 - Vasily R7AL, VIad R9LR, Mike RU3UR and Leo UI8J will be active as A25RU from Botswana from 15 March to 1 April. They will operate CW, SSB and FT8 (Fox \& Hound) on 160-10 metres with four stations. They also plan to be QRV on QO100. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, and eventually LoTW. CP - On 22 March Toni, EA5RM left for Bolivia [425DXN 1550], where he will be working on a non-governmental organization's project until 27 April. In his spare time he will operate SSB and digital modes as CP1XRM. QSL via EA5RM and LoTW. [TNX The Daily DX]
CT9 - Helmut, DF7EE will be active as CT9/DF7EE from Madeira (AF-014) on 20-31 March. He will participate in the CQ WW WPX SSB Contest as CQ3W. QSLs via LoTW and Club Log's OQRS.


DL - Special callsign DQ11WCA is active until 17 April from various WCA (World Castles Award) and WWFF sites. All QSOs are uploaded to Club Log and confirmed automatically via the bureau. [TNX DF6EX].

 DL - Celebrating World Amateur Radio Day, members of DARC's Special Event Station Team will be active as DA21WARD from 1 April through June. QSL via the bureau, or direct to DK5ON.
EA - The Mike Delta Victor DX Group (EA3RKM) is active as EH3DWN from 15 March to 1 April to mark World Down Syndrome Day (21 March). QSL via LoTW and eQSL only. See https://mikedeltavictor.com/ for more information.
EA - URE San Fernando (EA7URF) is participating in the official celebrations for the 500th anniversary of the first circumnavigation of the Earth [425DXN 1467]. The fifth in a series of AM500 special event stations representing a milestone of the voyage will be AM500MMM, to be active from 24 April to 2 May to memorialize Ferdinand Magellan's death on the island of Mactan (Philippines). QSL via EATURF (bureau or direct), LoTW and eQSL. Previously active were AM500SEV, AM500SAN, AM500ISJ and AM500ETS.
F - Special callsign TM150PAR will be active for fifteen days between 20 March and 16 May to mark the 150th anniversary of the Paris Commune, the revolutionary government that ruled Paris (18 March-28 May 1871) and had significant influence on the ideas of Karl Marx. QSL via F4HZS.

FG - Once again Philippe, F1DUZ will be active as FG4KH from Guadeloupe (NA-102) from 16 March to 1 April, including an entry in the CQ WW WPX SSB Contest. QSL via LoTW, eQSL, or direct to F1DUZ.

G - Celebrating Saint Patrick, patron saint of Ireland, the Welland Valley ARS will be active as GBOSP on 16-18 March. QSL via G4XEX, LoTW and eQSL
G - G5WS and G6ZZ will be used by the RSGB Contest Club to celebrate the centenary of the Transatlantic Tests which were held in the 1920s. The historic callsign 5WS was used by RSGB members from Wandsworth, in South London, during the third Transatlantic Tests (December 1922), while 6ZZ was used to test the practicability of radio communication to and from an express train using the amateur wavelengths (July 1924). QSLs via M0OXO's OQRS and LoTW.
GW - John, MW1CFN will be active as GB4FTS and GB1004FTS from Anglesey (EU-005) between 25 March and 8 April. He will operate SSB and digital modes on the HF bands, 6 and 2 m . QSL via LoTW or direct. The special callsigns celebrate the 100th anniversary of the Royal Air Force's No. 4 Flying Training School, opened on 1 April 1921.


HC - Rick, NE8Z will be active again as HC1MD/2 from the Santa Elena province of Ecuador between 5 March and 15 May. He will operate CW, SSB, FT8 and FT4 on 40-6 metres. QSL via K8LJG and LoTW. [TNX The

HL - Lee, HL1IWD will be active holiday style as HL1IWD/5 from Koje Island (AS081) on 2-4 April. He will operate CW and some FT8 on 40-20 metres. QSL via the bureau, or direct to EA5GL.
I - Alessandro, IU3EDK (SSB) and Andrea, IU1LCU (CW) plan to be active as IA5D from several islands in the Tuscan Archipelago (EU-028) in the coming weeks. The callsign is valid until the end of the year. QSL via IU3EDK.
I - Celebrating the 1600th anniversary of the founding of
 Venice, traditionally set on 25 March 421, and the 75th anniversary of ARI Venezia (http://www.arivenezia .it/), II3VE and IQ3VE will be active on various bands and modes from 15 March to 30 November. QSLs via the bureau. [TNX

I - Members of ARI Carpi (Modena) will operate special callsign II4CPC on 12-28 March to commemorate the 117th anniversary of the Chilean town of Capitan Pastene, founded by Italian settlers who arrived from

OE - The VIC Amateur Radio Contest DX Club (4U1A) is active again on all bands and modes as C7A (http://www.cqdx.ru/4 u1a/c7a/) throughout March. This activity counts for Austria for DXCC, and for the Vienna International Centre for the CQ DX Marathon. QSL via UA3DX, direct or bureau.
OH - The SSAB Raahe Amateur Radio Club (OH8SSAB) will be active as OF60RR until 1 March 2022 to celebrate the 60th anniversary of the Rautaruukki steel plant. QSL via the bureau, or direct to OH8DR.

 75th anniversary since the Soviet forces left the island after World War II (5 April 1946). Also, special callsign OZ75MAY will be reactivated during the same time frame. P4 - Jean-Pierre, P43A is active as P45A from 15 March to 15 April, including participation in the CQ WW WPX SSB Contest. The special prefix celebrates the 45th anniversary of Aruba's National Anthem and Flag (both adopted on 18 March 1976), as well as the 35th anniversary since the enaction of status aparte for the country. QSL via P43A.


PA - PF44F is the special callsign that Enno, PF5X will use to promote the Flora \& Fauna Netherlands Programme (http://www.pa-ff.nl/). The first activity will take place on 21 March from Grensmaas, part of the Natura 2000 European network of protected nature areas. QSL via LoTW; paper cards will not be available.

Janusz Wegrzyn, SP9FIH has won (for the fourth year in a row!) the 2020 Single-Operator Cass Award by working 6,845 unique stations during his one-man operation from Norfolk Island as VK9NK.
The HU1DL team (Andy Wolf DH8WR, Thomas Freimann DJ6TF, Werner Hasemann DJ9KH, Frank Milatz DL1KWK, Dietmar Lindner DL2HWA, Norbert Strauch DL2RNS, Georg Tretow DL4SVA, Olaf Matthaei DL7JOM, Rolf Thieme DL7VEE, and Franz Bernd DL9GFB) worked 19,456 unique stations from El Salvador to win the 2020 Unlimited Cass Award.

To earn the OH Northern Light 100-year Certificate ( $\mathrm{OH}-\mathrm{NL}-100$ ), contact fifty OH and fifty OF stations during 2021 (a special OF prefix will be launched to all OH stations on 15 September), and ten specially featured Finnish stations ("multipliers"). Multiplying your QSO points (maximum 100) by your multiplier value (max 10) will give you your score - maximum of 1000 points. The ten multipliers are:

All who score 1000 points and the top-ten continental highest scorers will receive their OH-NL-100 certificate signed by Santa Claus. A special lottery will feature additional special prizes that will be announced later. Your log extract should be sent to the Santa Claus offices (of9x@sral.fi) during January 2022. Owing to forecast blizzards, they decided to keep one station on the air until the very last moment while the camp was being dismantled, and to shut down on 26 March. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, which now contains 6,913 QSOs with more than 4,000 unique callsigns. The expedition's diary can be found at https://legendsarctic.com/dnevnik ekspedicii riOb 22.
