DX INFORMATION

4S - Members of the Radio Society of Sri Lanka, 4S7RS will be active as 4S7LGT from the lighthouse at Dondra Head, the southernmost point in Sri Lanka (AS-033) on 20-21 August during the ILLW. The ILLW Entrants List also mentions 4S7RS from Barberyn Lighthouse, located on Barberyn Island (AS-171). Plans are to operate CW, SSB and digi- tal modes on the HF bands. QSLs direct.



4X - Five light-house operations are expected to take place from Israel on 19-21 August: 4X01LH (Jaffa), 4X02LH (Stela Maris), 4X03LH (Ashdod), 4X04LH (Akko) and 4X05LH (Tel Aviv). QSLs via 4X6ZM. A certifi-

cate will be available, see https://iarc.org/lighthouse/.

5H - Eugen, DL8AAI will be active as 5H2JK/p during a hiking tour in Tanzania's Kilimanjaro National Park on 11-17 August, plus a few days before and after from the nearby town of Moshi. He will operate SSB (preferred frequencies 18144 and 21244 kHz), probably starting around 15 UTC. QSL via home call.



6Y - Amateur radio stations from Jamaica can use the 6Y60 prefix in celebration of the 60th anniversary since the Colony of Jamaica gained independence from the United Kingdom (6 August 1962) - e.g., 6Y5WE will be using 6Y60WE (QSL via EA5ZD), and 6Y5HM will be using 6Y60HM (QSL via EA5GL).

A3 - Masa, A35JP (JA0RQV) was off the air on 3-22 Au-



gust as he had to return to Japan owing to a family emergency. Masa resumed activity from Nuku'alofa (OC-049) on 25 August, and he expects to remain there until 30 September. In his spare time he operates CW, FT8, FT4 and

some SSB on 80-10 metres. QSL via LoTW, Club Log's OQRS, or via home call (bureau preferred). This will be his final operation from Tonga.

EA - URE San Fernando (EA7URF) is participating in the official celebrations for the 500th anniversary of the first circumnavigation of the Earth [425DXN 1467]. The last in a series of ten special event stations representing a



milestone of the voyage will be AM500PCM, to be activated on 3-19 September to memorialize the arrival of the ship Victoria, commanded by Juan Sebastian Elcano, in Sanlucar de Barrameda on 6 September 1522. Emperor Charles V granted Elcano an augmentation of his coat of arms featuring a world globe with the words Primus Circumdedisti Me ("You first encircled me"). QSL via EA7URF (bureau or direct), LoTW and eQSL. Previously active were AM7PVM (2018),AM500SEV

AM500SAN (2019), AM500ISJ (2020), AM500ETS (2020), AM500MMM (2021), AM500EMV (2021), AM500ESP (2021) and AM500TOR (2022).

EA8 - EG8HKT is the special callsign that members of Radio Club Islas Canarias (EA8RCK) will be using on 8-15 August in remembrance of St. Maximilian Maria Kolbe. QSL via eQSL only; a certificate will be available, see qrz.com for information. Born in 1894, Father Kolbe (SP3RN) was killed on 14 August 1941 at Auschwitz.







3Y0J: LATEST NEWS • The team «is currently staging all our 3,5 tons of equipment at Oslo airport in Norway, where we within the next few weeks will do final checks and pack all equipment», Ken, LA7GIA posted to Facebook on 19 August.



«Container shipping is scheduled for mid-September. Next weekend several team members from Norway and US will gather and go through all checklists to make sure all small items are in correct place.

We have detailed out the logistic plan, and have made a few changes. Among the improvements is that we have bought yet another outboard engine enabling us to use 2 zodiac boats simultaneously during beach landing to speed up the unloading of gear. In addition we have a third spare zodiac + engine.

We have also swapped the Yanmar generators with some 5 kW QRO lightweight generators that will enable us to run full station setup with only two out of four diesel gens. We have also added some 2000 litres of versatile, robust and hardwearing IBC diesel tanks in various sizes. One of the requirements from Norwegian Polar Insti-

tute is that there must be absolutely no spillage of diesel. Each IBC tank will be placed in a tray and guyed to withstand the strong Bouvet wind».
