

3A - All ARM members are allowed to use the special callsign 3A70ARM on 1-31 October to celebrate the 70th anniversary of the formation of the Association des Radioamateurs de Monaco. QSL via LoTW.



3D2/R - Darren, VK4MAP will be active holiday style as 3D2RAT from Rotuma Island (OC-060) on 13-29 September. He operates SSB on 80, 40, 20, 15, 12 and 10 metres. QSL direct to home call.
